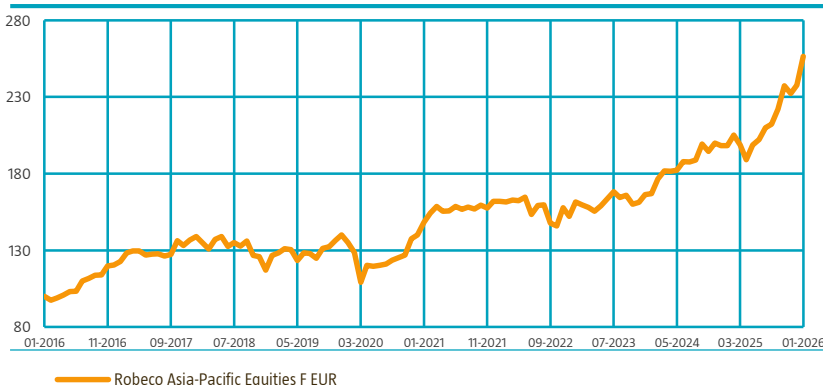

Performance

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was 7.89%.

The portfolio outperformed the benchmark by 375 bps in January. Japan, China India, South Korea and Australia were all large contributors, and there was a smaller contribution from Singapore. Detractors were quite muted, but Taiwan, Indonesia and Vietnam detracted at the margin, and there was a very small detraction from Thailand, the Philippines and Hong Kong. From a sector perspective, all sectors other than real estate contributed positively. Materials, consumer discretionary, industrials, financials and IT were the largest contributors.

Market development

In January, the MSCI Asia Pacific Index posted a strong gain of 7.6%, marking the third-best start to a year this century. This robust performance also contributed to the ongoing outperformance of emerging markets (EM), which rose 8.9%, compared to developed markets (DM), which increased by 2.3%. Despite various geopolitical events – such as developments in Venezuela, Greenland, and Iran – markets largely brushed these aside. Three major market trends stood out in January: Memory sector rally: Memory-related stocks continued to surge, even as broader global AI stocks paused. Commodity strength: Commodity stocks, especially those linked to gold and base metals, saw further gains. Bond and FX volatility: Volatility in developed market bonds and foreign exchange spilled over from movements in Japan.

Expectation of fund manager

There are few significant changes to highlight compared to last month's outlook. The main factors and arguments remain consistent. The valuation gap between Asia Pacific and the US continues to narrow. We are seeing an increase in volatility events, whether related to currency fluctuations (such as the yen) or sharp movements in stock prices, particularly around concerns about AI's impact on global software services. We anticipate that these types of events will remain a regular feature of the market landscape. As a result, there may be a rotation into sectors that are less affected by AI trends.

Top 10 largest positions

Samsung had been de-rated due to a product cycle miss in high-bandwidth memory and a weak NAND market, but low valuations and positive HBM developments have seen a re-rating begin. TSMC plays a crucial role in the energy transition as a top-tier chip manufacturer. Alibaba remains a reasonably-valued, cash-generating entity with significant exposure to the growth in Chinese consumer spending. Mizuho, a domestically-focused Japanese bank, is benefiting from increased interest rates and improving loan demand. SK hynix is the leading player in high bandwidth memory, a critical component in the AI buildout. Tencent is an IT player with significant exposure to the consumer via messaging, e-commerce, gaming and cloud services. IHI is now a focused play on the defense and aerospace industries, which are seeing strong growth. Mitsubishi Estate, with prime real estate in Tokyo, is poised for pricing power as demand remains strong and vacancy rates decline. Ping An, an integrated financial services company with leading-edge FinTech capabilities, stands to benefit from the growing wealth and savings market in China. BHP is a global leader in low cost commodities.

Sector allocation

The fund is currently underweight in consumer discretionary, IT and healthcare, due to concerns about their valuations. On the other hand, it is overweight in industrials, financials and real estate, where valuations are more attractive. At present, the fund does not have significant positions in sectors other than industrials, which includes reform plays in South Korea and Japan, along with defense. The opportunities available are stock-specific rather than sector-specific, driven by valuation differences and strategic variations.

Country allocation

Japan remains the fund's largest overweight. Good value, increased shareholder return, governance reform, and structural reform are all reasons to remain positive on the country. Payout ratio would have reached 40% in 2025. South Korea is the next largest overweight and has been the best performer given the new administration's focus on value-up policies and moving them to a more mandatory status. ASEAN is an overweight in general, but continues to be held back by political uncertainty. However, the region is close to record-low valuations, while having very strong medium-term drivers such as monetary stimulus and FDI, which can lead to significant multiplier effects and alpha opportunities, particularly in Indonesia, Vietnam and the Philippines. Demographics is a long-term positive. The fund has been cautious about India, Taiwan, and Australia due to high valuations, but we have reduced our underweight in India in the recent relative underperformance, on a stock-specific basis. Despite higher valuations, these markets still offer specific stock opportunities. China is relatively neutral after the recent move up in the market, and we will keep our focus on stock-specific opportunities.

Currency allocation

Precious metals experienced significant volatility in January, with gold and silver surging past USD 5,500/oz and USD 110/oz to record highs (amid concerns over geopolitical risks and Fed independence), before slumping on the last trading day of the month. Oil prices (Brent crude: +16.2%) also rose due to escalating tensions related to Iran. The 10-year US Treasury yield rose 6.9 bps to 4.24% in January, while the US dollar index fell further to 97. Most Asian currencies appreciated against the US dollar, but INR (-2.4%) depreciated significantly. JPY (+1.2%) once nearly depreciated to the 160 level, but rebounded following a BoJ intervention. Our only current currency position is a slight KRW hedge on our South Korea overweight.

Lastly, the fund makes use of shareholder rights and applies proxy voting in accordance with Robeco's proxy voting policy.

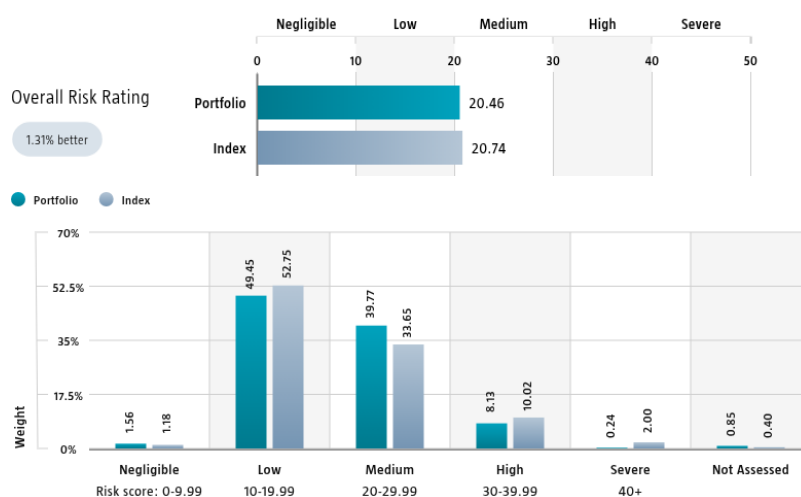

Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

The Portfolio Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating chart displays the portfolio's ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. The Distribution across Sustainalytics ESG Risk levels chart shows the portfolio allocations broken into Sustainalytics' five ESG risk levels: negligible (0-10), low (10-20), medium (20-30), high (30-40) and severe (40+), providing an overview of portfolio exposure to the different ESG risk levels. Index scores are provided alongside the portfolio scores, highlighting the portfolio's ESG risk level compared to the index.

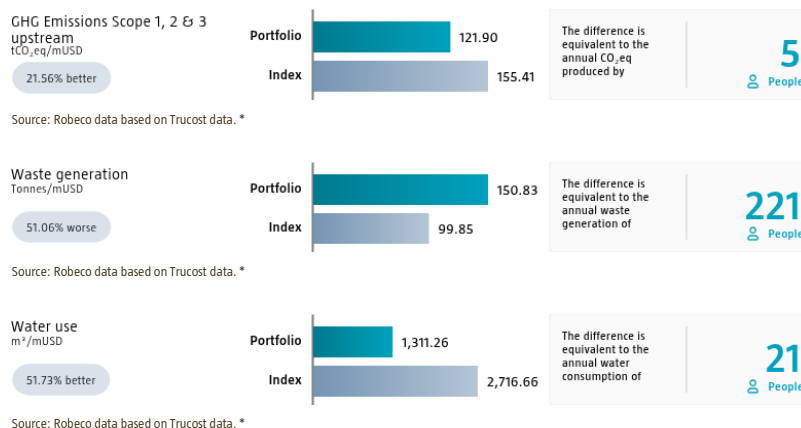

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Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. For comparison, index footprints are shown besides that of the portfolio. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. The framework utilizes a three-step approach to assess a company's impact alignment with the relevant SDGs and assign a total SDG score. The score ranges from positive to negative impact alignment with levels from high, medium or low impact alignment. This results in a 7-step scale from -3 to +3. Engagement

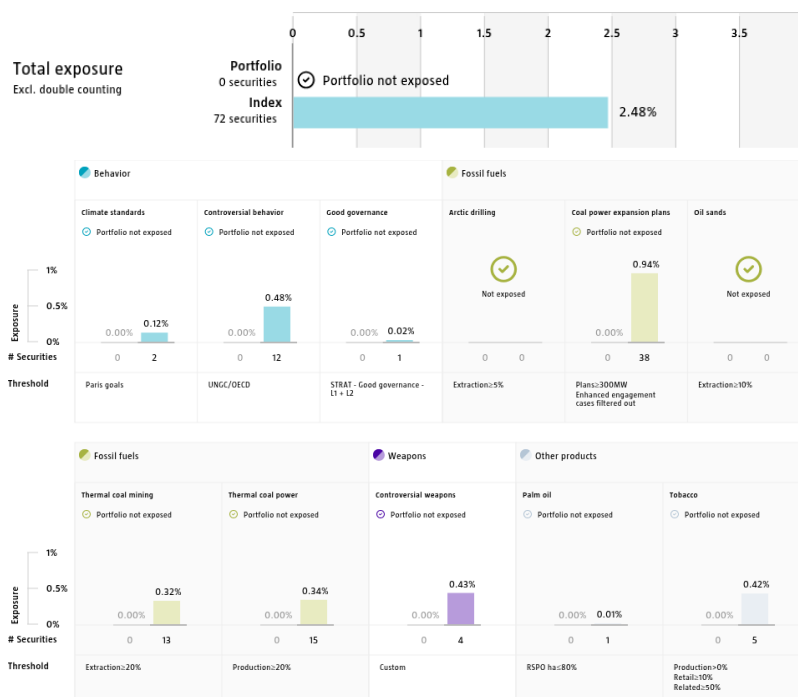
Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

The fund's objective is to achieve a better return than the index. The fund focuses on stocks of companies incorporated in Asia, Australia or New Zealand or those companies that exercise major part of economic activity from these regions. Country allocation is a less important performance driver, implemented via country and currency overlays.

The fund promotes E&S (i.e. Environmental and Social) characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of the European Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation, integrates sustainability risks in the investment process and applies Robeco's Good Governance policy. The fund applies sustainability indicators, including but not limited to, normative, activity-based and region-based exclusions, proxy voting and engagement.

Fund manager's CV

Joshua Crabb is Lead Portfolio Manager and Head of Asia Pacific Equities. Before joining Robeco in 2018, Joshua was Head of Asian Equities at Old Mutual and Portfolio Manager at BlackRock and Prudential in Hong Kong. He started his career in the investment industry as Sector Analyst at BT Financial Group in 1996. Joshua holds a Bachelor's with Honors in Finance from the University of Western Australia and he is a CFA® charterholder. Harfun Ven is Portfolio Manager in the Asia Pacific team with a focus on cyclical sectors. Prior to joining Robeco in 2008, he was Portfolio Manager Japanese Equities at Alliance Trust. Harfun also managed Premier Alliance Trust Japan Equity, a top quartile ranked fund. Before that, he spent six years with Bowen Capital Management, managing both Japan-only and Asia-Pacific funds. He started his career in the investment industry in 1998. Having grown up in Japan, he fluently speaks Japanese, Cantonese and English. Harfun holds an MBA from Boston University and a Bachelor's from the University of Massachusetts.

The fund is subject to an annual subscription tax ('tax d'abonnement') in Luxembourg, which amounts to 0.05% of the net asset value of the fund. This tax is included in the net asset value of the fund. The fund can in principle use the Luxembourg treaty network to partially recover any withholding tax on its income.

Fiscal treatment of investor

The fiscal consequences of investing in this fund depend on the investor's personal situation.
