The fund primarily invests in short-dated bonds and interest rate duration range between 1-6 years, while, at the same time, invest in companies that contribute to realizing the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The selection of these bonds is based on fundamental analysis. Performance drivers are the top-down beta positioning as well as bottom-up issuer selection. The portfolio is built on the basis of the eligible investment universe and the relevant SDGs using an internally developed framework about which more information can be obtained via the website [www.robeco.com/si](http://www.robeco.com/si). The fund's objective is to maximize current income.

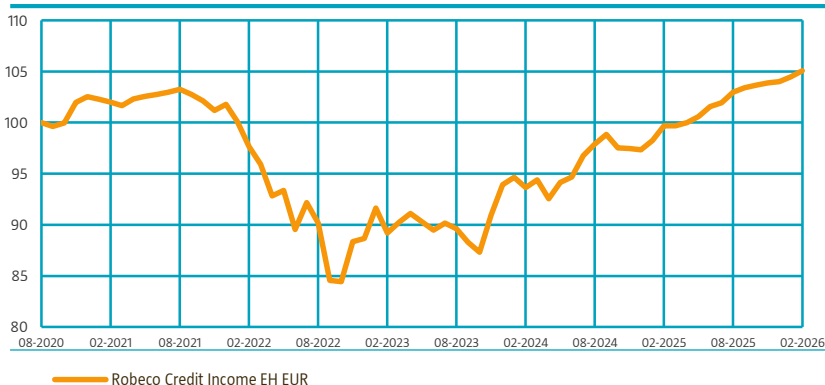

### Performance

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was 0.57%.

The fund had a positive total return in February. Cash yields continued to make a positive contribution, but duration exposure also contributed positively as treasury yields declined sharply in February. The total contribution from credit was positive in February. Although overall market exposure of the portfolio was relatively cautious, the total impact of credit exposure was negative in February. Issuer selection results were strong in February. The convertible bond of Helios Tower had a strong run. Also, the position in Brazilian conglomerate CSN, which was added after a sharp drop in prices, contributed positively. The position in chemical company Alpeka contributed negatively, as the company reported disappointing fourth quarter results.

### Market development

February turned out to be a weaker month for credit markets. High yield spreads increased 25 bps and closed the month at 308 bps, while investment grade spreads rose 10 bps to 85 bps. Emerging market spreads rose 18 bps to 242 bps. Software companies remained under pressure, as the market continued to focus on the impact of AI on the future prospects of these companies. Fears about the exposure of private credit portfolios to software led to continued pressure on the BDC sector. The tech sector underperformed versus broader market indices in February. The January jobs report and ISM manufacturing showed that the US economy is in decent shape and expectations for Fed cuts in 2026 declined. The longer end of the treasury curve rallied on fears of the longer-term impact of AI on the economy. 10-year US yields were down 30 bps, while the 2-year part was only down 15 bps. On the final weekend of February 2026, the US and Israel launched coordinated military strikes on Iran. As markets were closed, the impact of the attacks on markets is not reflected in this month's report.

### Expectation of fund manager

The recent events in the Middle East could lead to broader weakness in markets. Energy prices are going up and supply from the Middle East is at risk. Energy intensive sectors in Europe and Asia could be impacted, while the cost benefit for North American companies will increase. With many countries in Latin America being energy exporters, companies in this region could benefit. Higher energy costs could put pressure on consumer spending, while the inflationary impact of higher energy prices will give central banks less room to lower rates. As markets have only seen moderate spread widening, we continue to prefer shorter spread duration instruments. Issuer selection will remain key in the potentially more volatile environment.

### Top 10 largest positions

The top ten positions mostly consist of high yield-rated corporates and holdings in subordinated financials. Our subordinated financials positions are mainly in Tier-2 securities. Our high yield holdings are to a large extent in subordinated financials.

The positions in the chemical sector are mainly active in North America and their relative cost position will further improve with recent events in the Middle East. Exposure to software companies and the broader technology sector for the portfolio is very small. In February, some exposure to Oracle was added. The portfolio also has no exposure to BDCs at the moment;

### Subordination allocation

The fund holds a significant allocation to banking and insurance, mainly via subordinated bonds. In CoCo bonds, we prefer shorter-dated calls with high reset spreads. With index spreads close to historical tights, selection should focus on instruments with limited extension risk. For instruments with lower reset spreads, we have a clear preference for the higher-quality higher-rated issuers.

## Sustainability

Sustainability is incorporated in the investment process by the means of a target universe, exclusions, ESG integration, and a minimum allocation to ESG-labeled bonds. The fund solely invests in credits issued by companies with a positive or neutral impact on the SDGs. The impact of issuers on the SDGs is determined by applying Robeco's internally developed three-step SDG Framework. The outcome is a quantified contribution expressed as an SDG score, considering both the contribution to the SDGs (positive, neutral or negative) and the extent of this contribution (high, medium or low). In addition, the fund does not invest in credit issuers that are in breach of international norms or where activities have been deemed detrimental to society following Robeco's exclusion policy. ESG factors are integrated in the bottom-up security analysis to assess the impact of financially material ESG risk on the issuer's fundamental credit quality. Furthermore, the fund invests at least 5% in green, social, sustainable, and/or sustainability-linked bonds. Lastly, where a credit issuer is flagged for breaching international standards in the ongoing monitoring, the issuer will become subject to exclusion.

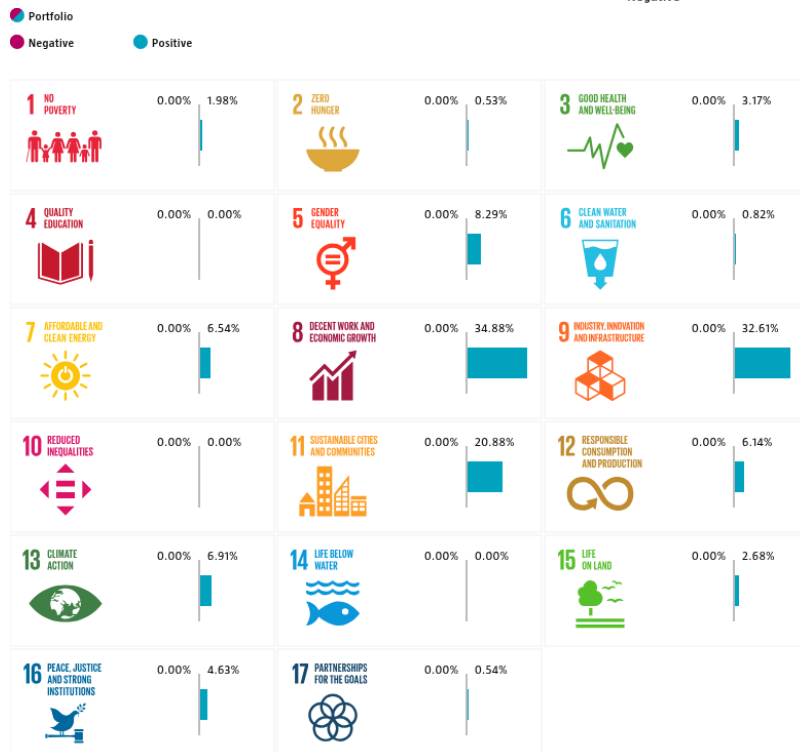
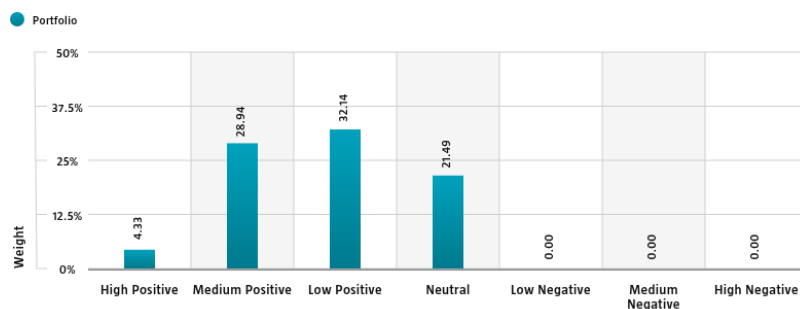

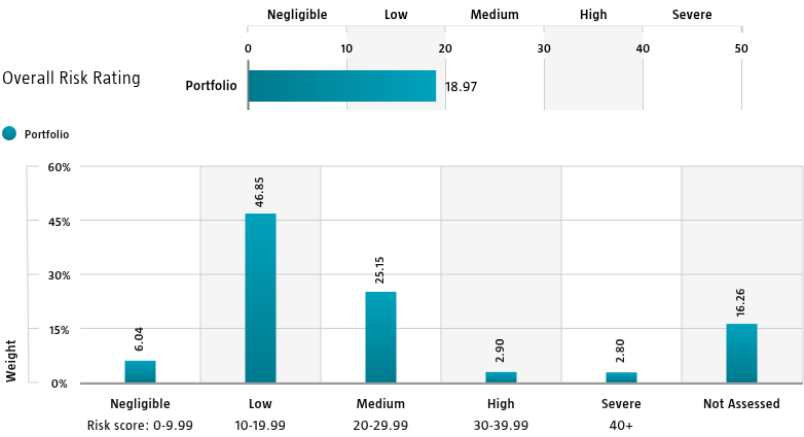

Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

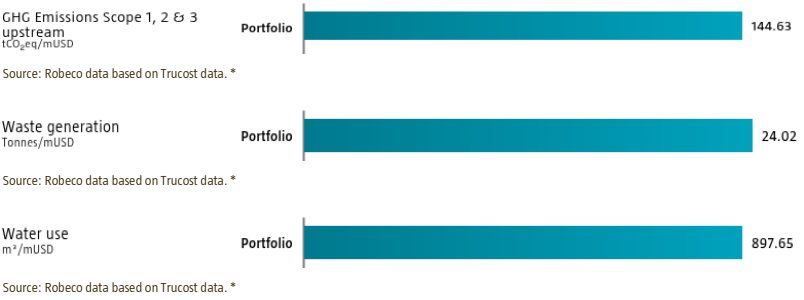
The Portfolio Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating chart displays the portfolio's ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. 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Environmental Footprint

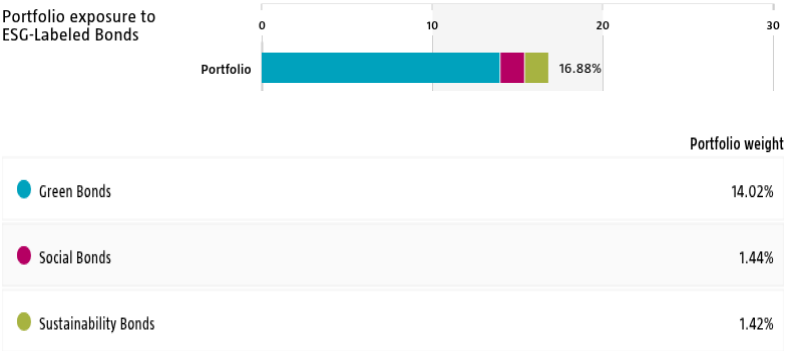
Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. For comparison, index footprints are shown besides that of the portfolio. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.



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ESG Labeled Bonds

### Engagement

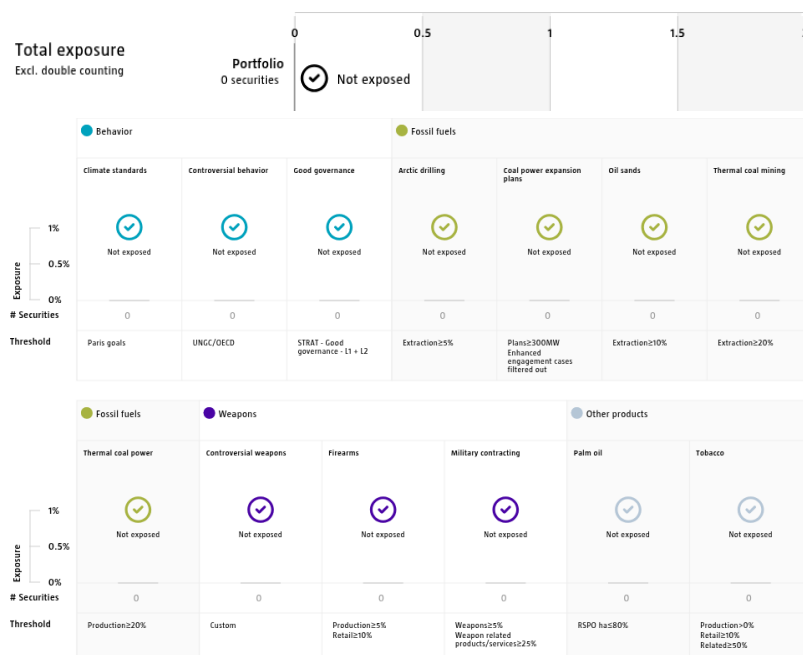
Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

He joined the Credit team in 2016. Previously, Jan Willem headed the Financials Equity sell-side research team at ABN AMRO. He started his career in the industry in 1999 at APG, where he held several positions including Portfolio Manager of a global insurance portfolio and subsequently a pan-European financials portfolio. Jan Willem holds a Master's in Business Economics from the University of Groningen and he is a CFA® charterholder.

## Fiscal treatment of investor

The fiscal consequences of investing in this fund depend on the investor's personal situation.
