About the fund

Robeco Credit Income is an actively managed fund that invests in global investment grade credit, high yield and emerging credits to optimize yield and income through the credit cycle. The fund primarily invests in short-dated bonds and interest rate duration range between 1-6 years, while, at the same time, invest in companies that contribute to realizing the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The selection of these bonds is based on fundamental analysis. Performance drivers are the top-down beta positioning as well as bottom-up issuer selection. The portfolio is built on the basis of the eligible investment universe and the relevant SDGs using an internally developed framework about which more information can be obtained via the website www.robeco.com/si. The fund's objective is to maximize current income.

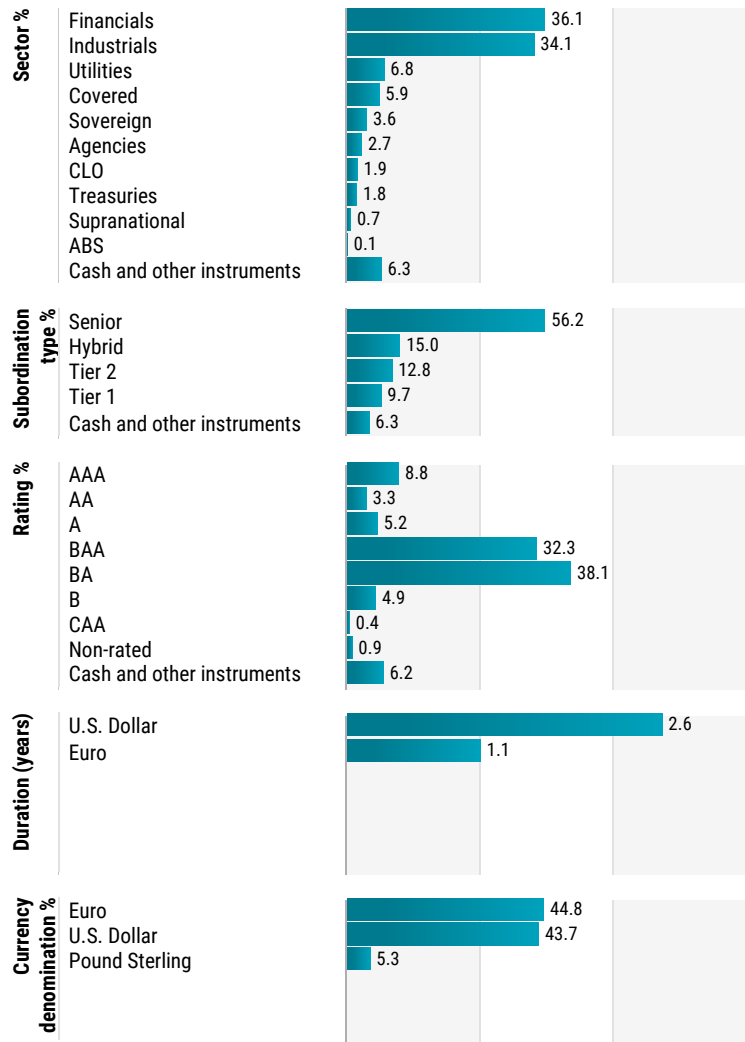

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Market development

The conflict in the Gulf region escalated once again, leading to a renewed disruption of shipping traffic through the Strait of Hormuz. As a result, oil prices rose above USD 90 per barrel. Toward the end of the month, however, signs of progress toward reopening the strait helped ease concerns, and oil prices retraced part of their earlier gains. The Federal Reserve left interest rates unchanged at its July meeting, although three FOMC members voted in favor of a rate hike. Fed Chair Warsh provided limited guidance during the subsequent press conference, which was poorly received by bond markets. As a result, treasury yields moved sharply higher. Investors also became more skeptical about the expected returns on AI-related investments. This shift in sentiment triggered significant moves within the technology sector. In credit markets, spreads on data center bonds widened as the anticipated wave of new issuance put pressure on valuations. Spreads on bonds issued by highly rated semiconductor companies also widened materially during the month. For another month, market volatility was concentrated primarily in government bond markets rather than credit spreads.

Expectation of fund manager

The situation in the Gulf region remains unpredictable. While the global economy has so far proved resilient in the face of higher oil prices, geopolitical risks remain elevated. Nevertheless, economic growth is likely to remain reasonably robust, supported by continued investment in technology and ongoing fiscal stimulus measures. Inflation, however, is expected to remain a key challenge for policymakers. In this environment, we expect higher-carry assets, such as subordinated debt and high yield bonds, to continue to perform well. However, despite the more constructive macroeconomic backdrop, credit spreads remain tight by historical standards, warranting a selective investment approach with a focus on shorter spread-duration instruments. Inflation remains above central bank targets, supported by continued economic strength and energy price volatility. As a result, we maintain a cautious duration stance, favoring intermediate maturities where valuations appear more balanced and exposure to interest-rate risk is less pronounced.

Top 10 largest holdings

The top ten positions mostly consist of high yield-rated corporates and holdings in subordinated financials. Our subordinated financials positions are mainly in Tier-2 securities. Our high yield holdings are to a large extent in subordinated financials.

Sector allocation

After the widening in the technology sector, we have started to add exposure in specific data center deals. These bonds trade at attractive spreads for their rating and are backed by lease commitments from AA-rated companies. We also added exposure to semiconductor companies.

Currency denomination allocation

The currency exposure is hedged back to the fund's base currency.

Duration allocation

After the rise in yields in July, we added some duration in 10-year EUR at the end of the month.

Rating allocation

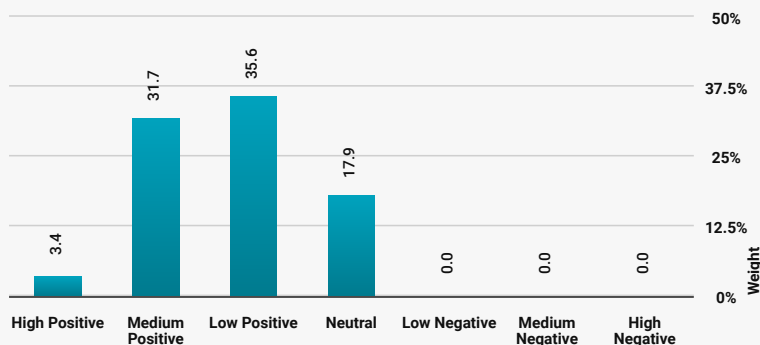
The majority of the fund is invested in the BBB-BB space. At the moment, shorter-dated BB credits offer value in our view.

Subordination allocation

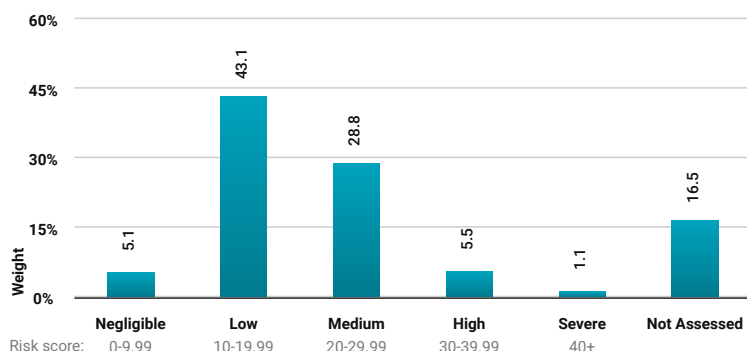
The fund holds a significant allocation to banking and insurance, mainly via subordinated bonds. Instruments with high resets have shown a strong rally. The fund is switching to higher-spread alternatives, with a focus on higher-quality issuers. We added to subordinated bonds of ABN Amro and Crédit Agricole, among others.

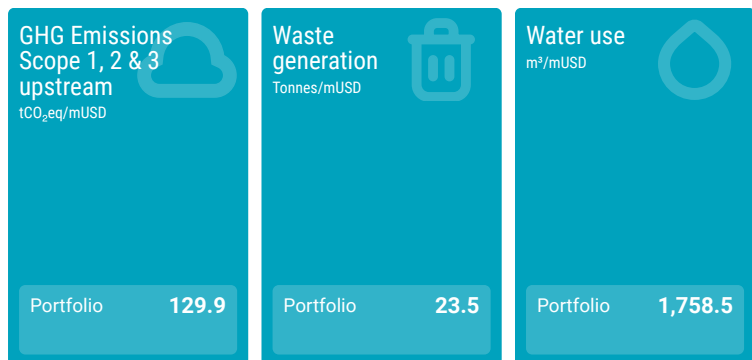

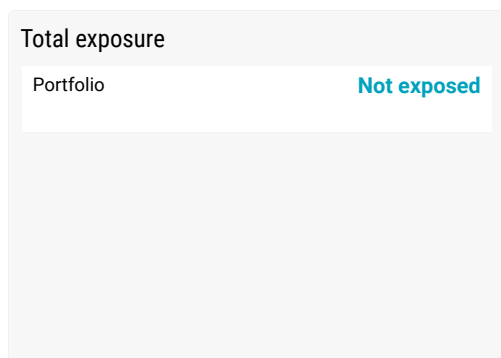

The fund has sustainable investment as its objective within the meaning of Article 8 of the European Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation. The fund advances the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by investing in companies whose business models and operational practices are aligned with targets defined by the 17 UN SDGs. The fund integrates ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) factors in the investment process, applies Robeco's Good Governance policy. The fund applies sustainability indicators, including but not limited to normative, activity-based and region-based exclusions.

1. SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. The framework utilizes a three-step approach to assess a company's impact alignment with the relevant SDGs and assign a total SDG score. The score ranges from positive to negative impact alignment with levels from high, medium or low impact alignment. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

2. Sustainability ESG Risk Rating

The chart displays the portfolio's Sustainability ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainability ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. The distribution across Sustainability ESG Risk levels chart shows the portfolio allocations broken into Sustainability's five ESG risk levels: negligible (0-10), low (10-20), medium (20-30), high (30-40) and severe (40+), providing an overview of portfolio exposure to the different ESG risk levels. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

3. ESG Labeled Bonds

The visual displays the portfolio's exposure to ESG-labeled bonds. This is calculated as a sum of weights for those bonds in the portfolio that have one of above mentioned labels. Index exposure figures are provided alongside the portfolio exposure figures, highlighting the difference with the index.

4. Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index (where applicable) represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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5. Engagement

Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

6. Exclusions

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Risk management

Risk management is fully embedded in the investment process to ensure that positions always meet predefined guidelines.

Fiscal product treatment

The fund is established in Luxembourg and is subject to the Luxembourg tax laws and regulations. The fund is not liable to pay any corporation, income, dividend or capital gains tax in Luxembourg. The fund is subject to an annual subscription tax ('tax d'abonnement') in Luxembourg, which amounts to 0.05% of the net asset value of the fund. This tax is included in the net asset value of the fund. The fund can in principle use the Luxembourg treaty network to partially recover any withholding tax on its income.

Fiscal treatment of investor

The fiscal consequences of investing in this fund depend on the investor's personal situation. For private investors in the Netherlands real interest and dividend income or capital gains received on their investments are not relevant for tax purposes. Each year investors pay income tax on the value of their net assets as at 1 January if and inasmuch as such net assets exceed the investor's tax-free allowance. Any amount invested in the fund forms part of the investor's net assets. Private investors who are resident outside the Netherlands will not be taxed in the Netherlands on their investments in the fund. However, such investors may be taxed in their country of residence on any income from an investment in this fund based on the applicable national fiscal laws. Other fiscal rules apply to legal entities or professional investors. We advise investors to consult their financial or tax adviser about the tax consequences of an investment in this fund in their specific circumstances before deciding to invest in the fund.

Dividend policy

This share class aims to distribute dividend on a monthly basis. The frequency of dividend distributions is an aim and not a guarantee. The Fund may, at their discretion, pay dividends out of capital or capital gains.
