The fund primarily invests in short-dated bonds and interest rate duration range between 1-6 years, while, at the same time, invest in companies that contribute to realizing the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The selection of these bonds is based on fundamental analysis. Performance drivers are the top-down beta positioning as well as bottom-up issuer selection. The portfolio is built on the basis of the eligible investment universe and the relevant SDGs using an internally developed framework. The fund's objective is to maximize current income.


