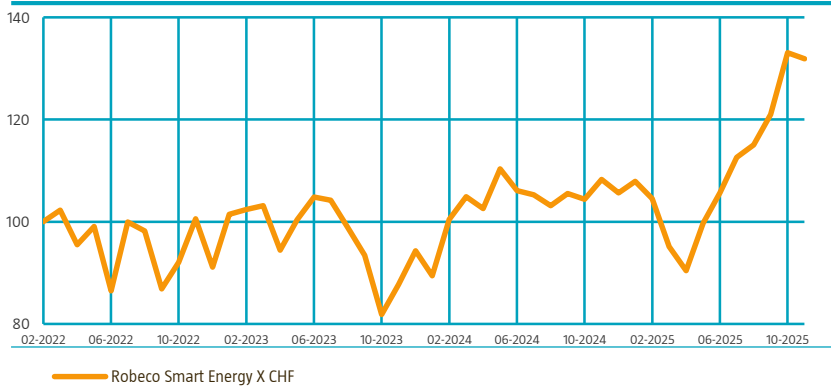

### Performance

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was -0.93%.

The Energy Distribution cluster was the only positive performer in November, led by Electric Networks and SSE, which announced a major grid expansion plan and a smaller-than-expected equity raise. Equipment suppliers lagged, though SWCC beat expectations and raised guidance, while Quanta Services hit a record high on strong US grid spending outlook. HD Hyundai Electric paused after strong YTD gains. Renewable Energies were slightly negative: Wind rebounded with Vestas posting solid Q3 results, while Solar saw First Solar outperform on new US capacity plans; Nextpower slipped on profit-taking. Energy Efficiency declined overall, despite Big Data gains from Lumentum; Arm fell on AI-related weakness. Energy Management underperformed, though ADI and Infineon led Power Semis; Alpha & Omega and Monolithic Power dropped on AI sentiment. Energy Storage softened as CATL consolidated post lock-up expiry.

### Market development

Global equity markets dipped slightly in euro terms in November after strong gains since April, amid heightened volatility. A late-month US rally, driven by optimism over a likely Fed rate cut, offset mid-month weakness tied to concerns about AI infrastructure investments. US economic data resumed after a record shutdown, reinforcing expectations of a December cut with futures pricing at 90%. Global manufacturing improved, PMI was above 50, supported by reshoring and data center investment, though regional trends varied: US mixed, Europe near 50, China still below.

### Expectation of fund manager

As we move into 2026, we anticipate a continued gradual decline in inflation rates. However, recently implemented global tariffs may pose short-term inflationary pressures. In the United States, interest rates are expected to trend lower, which should support both economic activity and investor sentiment – particularly benefiting the construction sector, which has been adversely affected by elevated rates. Meanwhile, the Global Manufacturing PMI continues to rise, indicating accelerating growth. This momentum is partly driven by reshoring initiatives and the rapid expansion of data center infrastructure. Nonetheless, headline risks remain, including geopolitical tensions, trade barriers, and concerns regarding the Federal Reserve's independence. The investment team will maintain close oversight of these developments and will adjust portfolio positioning as necessary to reflect evolving market dynamics.

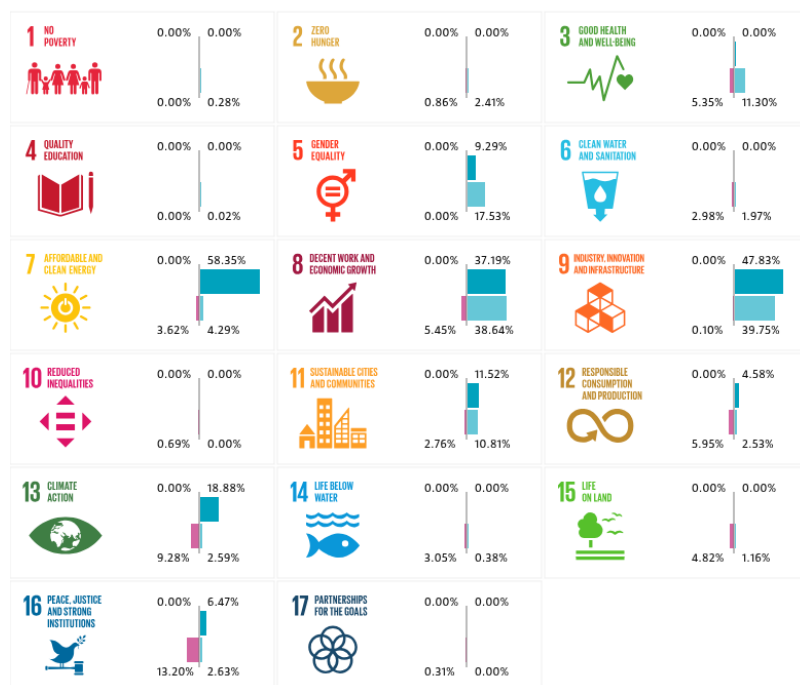
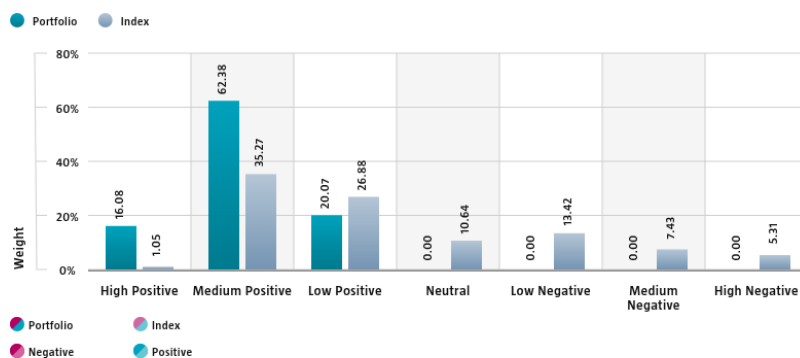

## Sustainability

The fund's sustainable investment objective is to further the transformation and decarbonization of the global energy sector. The transformation and decarbonization of the energy sector and sustainability considerations are incorporated in the investment process by the means of a target universe definition, exclusions, ESG integration, a carbon footprint target and voting. The fund only invests in companies that have a significant thematic fit as per Robeco's thematic universe methodology. Through screening on both Robeco's internally developed SDG Framework and Robeco's exclusion policy, the fund does not invest in issuers that have a negative impact on the SDGs, are in breach of international norms or where products have been deemed controversial. Financially material ESG factors are integrated in the bottom-up fundamental investment analysis to assess existing and potential ESG risks and opportunities. The fund's weighted carbon footprint will be equal to or better than that of its Climate Transition Benchmark. In addition, where a stock issuer is flagged for breaching international standards in the ongoing monitoring, the issuer will become subject to exclusion. Lastly, the fund makes use of shareholder rights and applies proxy voting in accordance with Robeco's proxy voting policy. For more information please visit the sustainability-related disclosures. ## SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

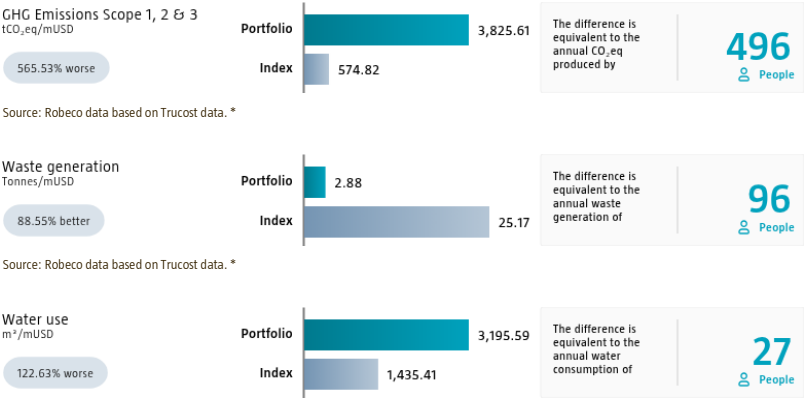

Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. For comparison, index footprints are shown besides that of the portfolio. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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Engagement

Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

The fund integrates ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) factors in the investment process and applies Robeco's Good Governance policy. The fund applies sustainability indicators, including but not limited to normative, activity-based and region-based exclusions, carbon reduction target and proxy voting.
