The fund has sustainable investment as its objective, within the meaning of Article 9 of the Regulation (EU) 2019/2088 of 27 November 2019 on Sustainability-related disclosures in the financial sector. The fund's objective is also to achieve a better return than the Benchmark. The strategy integrates sustainability criteria as part of the stock selection process and through a theme-specific sustainability assessment. The portfolio is built on the basis of an eligible investment universe that includes companies whose business models contribute to the thematic investment objectives. 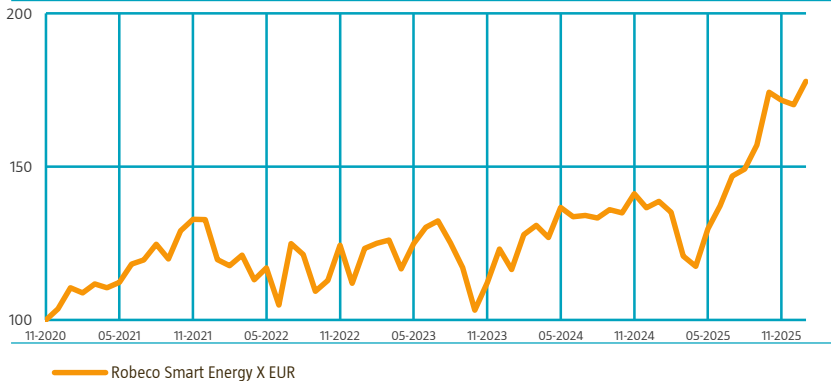

### Performance

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was 4.51%.

The Energy Management cluster showed mixed performance. Power Semiconductors rebounded sharply as improving sales momentum and signs of stabilization in industrial and automotive end markets lifted key holdings, led by Power Integrations and Monolithic Power Systems, while InnoScience detracted. Energy Storage was steadier, with CATL consolidating. Energy Distribution was a strong contributor, supported by rising investment in grids and equipment amid accelerating capex and robust demand, benefiting names such as SSE, Elia, Prysmian and HD Hyundai Electric. Renewables performed in-line overall, with wind companies outperforming on strong order momentum and improving margins, while solar and power producers were more mixed. Energy Efficiency lagged, though early cyclical recovery signs supported selected industrial names.

### Market development

Global equities posted gains in January, extending late-2025 momentum despite an intense stream of geopolitical headlines. Volatility stayed largely contained, underscoring investors' focus on growth and earnings over political noise. Early-month shocks – including US action in Venezuela and renewed rhetoric around Greenland – briefly triggered risk-off moves, but markets proved resilient and recovered by month-end. US macro data surprised positively, with low inflation and strong growth keeping the Fed on hold in a pragmatic stance that anchored sentiment. Performance was broadly positive but uneven: US small caps and cyclicals outperformed, technology lagged, Europe led to new highs, and Asia advanced, driven by Japan and AI-linked names.

### Expectation of fund manager

For 2026, we expect inflation to continue its gradual downward trajectory. In the United States, interest rates are projected to move lower, which should lend support to both economic activity and investor sentiment – particularly within the construction sector, which has been constrained by higher financing costs. At the same time, the global manufacturing PMI is trending upward, signaling accelerating growth. In the long term, we believe a new Industrial Revolution is transforming electricity grids/infrastructure across the US and Europe. After nearly two decades of stagnation, electricity demand is on the rise, fueled by energy-intensive data centers driven by the AI industry, electric vehicles and the heating and cooling of buildings. This, coupled with government incentives for clean energy infrastructure development, has spurred a surge of new construction projects to upgrade energy systems and modernize the grid.

Infineon is the largest semiconductor company in automotive and has a market leading power semiconductor portfolio, part of the Semiconductor Power Management subcluster; Quanta Services is the largest and leading specialized US contractor in electric T&D and part of the Energy Distribution cluster; Vertiv provides data center power management and cooling systems, part of Energy Efficiency Big Data; SSE is a UK-based electricity transmission operator and renewable power developer and part of the Electric Network subcluster; nVent Electric is a global provider of electrical connection products and protection solution and is part of the Energy Distribution cluster.

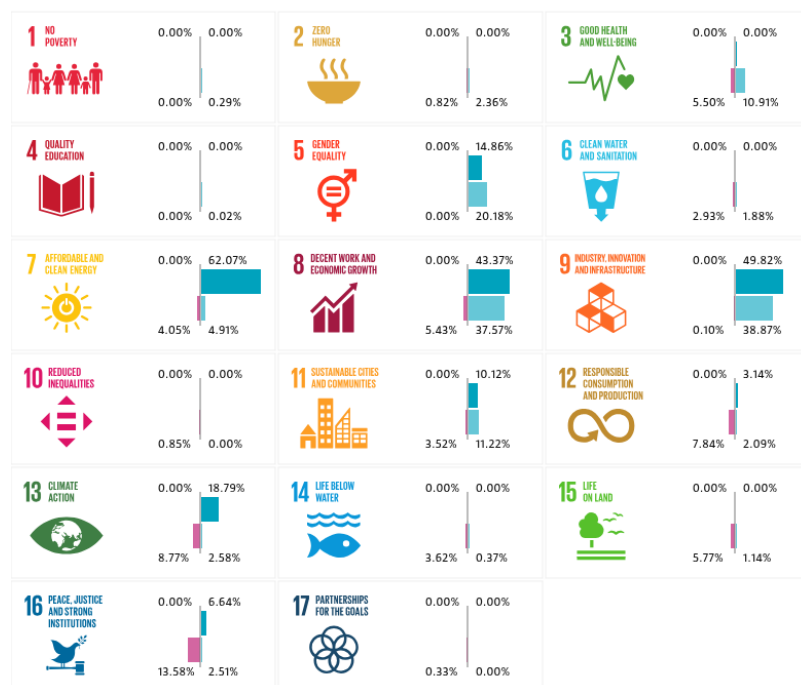
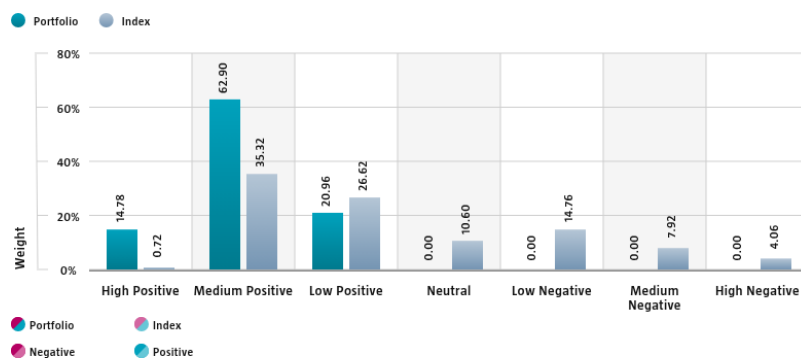
The fund's sustainable investment objective is to further the transformation and decarbonization of the global energy sector. The transformation and decarbonization of the energy sector and sustainability considerations are incorporated in the investment process by the means of a target universe definition, exclusions, ESG integration, a carbon footprint target and voting. The fund only invests in companies that have a significant thematic fit as per Robeco's thematic universe methodology. Through screening on both Robeco's internally developed SDG Framework and Robeco's exclusion policy, the fund does not invest in issuers that have a negative impact on the SDGs, are in breach of international norms or where products have been deemed controversial. Financially material ESG factors are integrated in the bottom-up fundamental investment analysis to assess existing and potential ESG risks and opportunities. The fund's weighted carbon footprint will be equal to or better than that of its Climate Transition Benchmark. In addition, where a stock issuer is flagged for breaching international standards in the ongoing monitoring, the issuer will become subject to exclusion. Lastly, the fund makes use of shareholder rights and applies proxy voting in accordance with Robeco's proxy voting policy. For more information please visit the sustainability-related disclosures.

## SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

The Portfolio Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating chart displays the portfolio's ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. 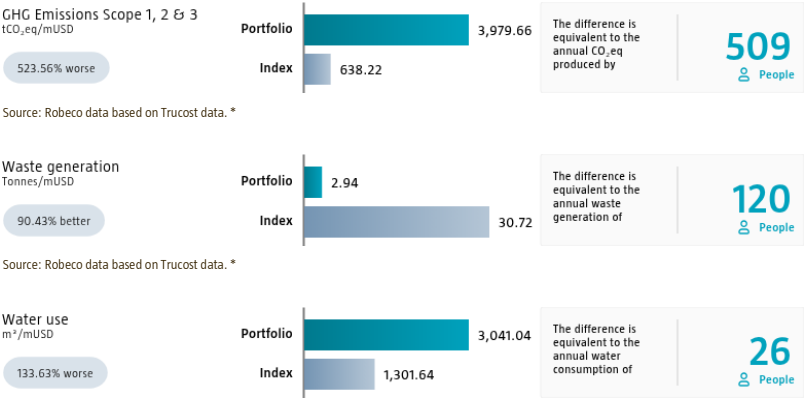

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Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. For comparison, index footprints are shown besides that of the portfolio. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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## Engagement

Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

This is done by investing in companies that advance the following UN Sustainable Development Goals (UN SDGs): Affordable and Clean Energy goal, Decent work and economic growth, Industry, innovation and infrastructure, Sustainable cities and communities, and Climate action. The fund integrates ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) factors in the investment process and applies Robeco's Good Governance policy. The fund applies sustainability indicators, including but not limited to normative, activity-based and region-based exclusions, carbon reduction target and proxy voting.

### Fiscal product treatment

The fund is established in Luxembourg and is subject to the Luxembourg tax laws and regulations. The fund is not liable to pay any corporation, income, dividend or capital gains tax in Luxembourg. The fund is subject to an annual subscription tax ("tax d'abonnement") in Luxembourg, which amounts to 0.05% of the net asset value of the fund. This tax is included in the net asset value of the fund. The fund can in principle use the Luxembourg treaty network to partially recover any withholding tax on its income.

### Fiscal treatment of investor

The fiscal consequences of investing in this fund depend on the investor's personal situation. For private investors in the Netherlands real interest and dividend income or capital gains received on their investments are not relevant for tax purposes. Each year investors pay income tax on the value of their net assets as at 1 January if and inasmuch as such net assets exceed the investor's tax-free allowance. Any amount invested in the fund forms part of the investor's net assets. Private investors who are resident outside the Netherlands will not be taxed in the Netherlands on their investments in the fund. However, such investors may be taxed in their country of residence on any income from an investment in this fund based on the applicable national fiscal laws. Other fiscal rules apply to legal entities or professional investors.
