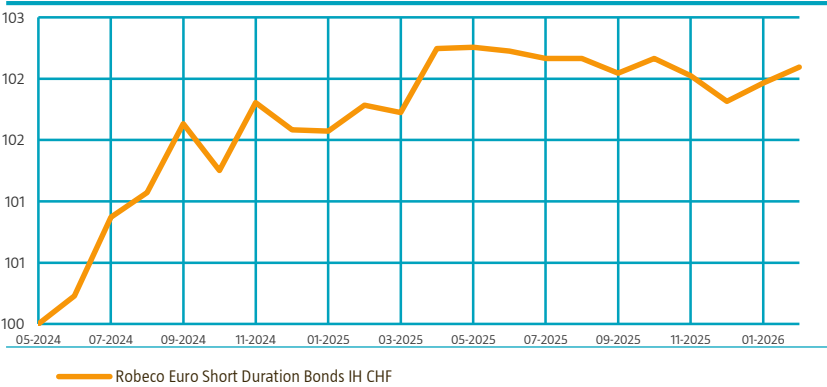

Performance

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was 0.13%. The fund's return (gross of fees) was slightly higher than that of the benchmark in February. The main contributor to relative performance was the duration overweight. The curve-flattening bias also contributed positively. In contrast, the overweight in corporate bonds detracted from relative performance, but this was mostly offset by the contribution of the underweight in French and Italian government bonds.

Market development

Government bond returns were positive over February. 10-year US Treasuries ended the month 30 basis points lower at 3.94%, while the German Bund rallied by 20 basis points to 2.64%. In the UK, Gilts also rallied by 29 basis points to 4.23%. US Treasuries performed well over February, as US labor market data disappointed at the beginning of the month. US job openings surprised to the downside and unemployment claims were somewhat higher than expected. The US Supreme Court struck down the Trump administration's IEEPA tariffs. In response, the US president invoked a 10% global tariff rate under a different law. In Europe, the February ECB meeting showed that the central bank is not in a rush to change rates, with president Lagarde downplaying the importance of the recent strength in the euro. Toward the end of the month, yields globally continued to move lower in response to a possible US attack on Iran.

Expectation of fund manager

Despite the neutral near-term guidance from the Fed, we continue to expect at least two additional 25 bps cuts this year. This outlook is premised on renewed signs of labor market cooling and a more dovish FOMC composition. May will likely be the first meeting chaired by Kevin Warsh. We then expect the Fed's easing bias to become more pronounced. For the ECB, we expect them to either keep rates unchanged in our base case for the upcoming quarters or potentially cut policy rates in response to an external shock. While the build-up of US military assets in the Middle East drove the bid in duration over past weeks, any further escalation could disrupt global oil supplies, particularly if tanker traffic through the Strait of Hormuz is impeded. This will likely have the reversed effect, with bond yields selling off instead. Peripheral bond spreads over Germany can continue to converge in a broader risk-friendly market environment, but in the shorter term, much will depend on whether tensions in the Middle East will ease in coming days, or will intensify further.

Duration allocation

The duration of the fund is slightly higher than that of the index. Over the month, the duration overweight was reduced significantly, taking profit on the rally in government bond yields. With valuations normalizing, we are becoming less constructive on duration. With the ECB firmly in pausing mode, we see front-end yields trading in a narrow range. For the ECB, the bar for either a cut or a hike will be very high.

Rating allocation

The fund has roughly 39% invested in AAA/AA bonds, mainly comprising government-related bonds and Dutch and German government bonds. The average rating of the fund is AA3/A1, which is the same as that of the index. The lower allocation to the AA-rated segment compared to the index is driven by the underweight position in semi-core government bonds.

Country allocation

The fund maintained an overweight position in Dutch government bonds and underweight positions in French and Italian government bonds. Although short-dated French government bonds have benefited from reduced uncertainty around the 2026 budget, the fundamentals remain challenging and the upside remains limited. We continue to prefer short-dated credit over French and Italian government bonds on these tenors.

Sustainability

Sustainability is incorporated in the investment process by the means of a target universe, exclusions, ESG integration, and a minimum allocation to ESG-labeled bonds. The fund solely invests in bonds and credits issued by countries and companies with a positive or neutral impact on the SDGs. The impact of issuers on the SDGs is determined by applying Robeco's internally developed three-step SDG Framework. The outcome is a quantified contribution expressed as an SDG score, considering both the contribution to the SDGs (positive, neutral or negative) and the extent of this contribution (high, medium or low).

Also, for government and government-related bonds, the fund complies with Robeco's exclusion policy for countries, excludes the 15% worst ranked countries following the World Governance Indicator 'Control of Corruption'. For corporate bonds, the fund does not invest in credit issuers that are in breach of international norms or where activities have been deemed detrimental to society following Robeco's exclusion policy. Financially material ESG factors are integrated in the bottom-up security analysis to assess the impact on the issuer's fundamental credit quality.

Furthermore, the fund invests at least 2,5% in social, sustainable, and/or sustainability-linked bonds. Lastly, where a credit issuer is flagged for breaching international standards in the ongoing monitoring, the issuer will become subject to exclusion.

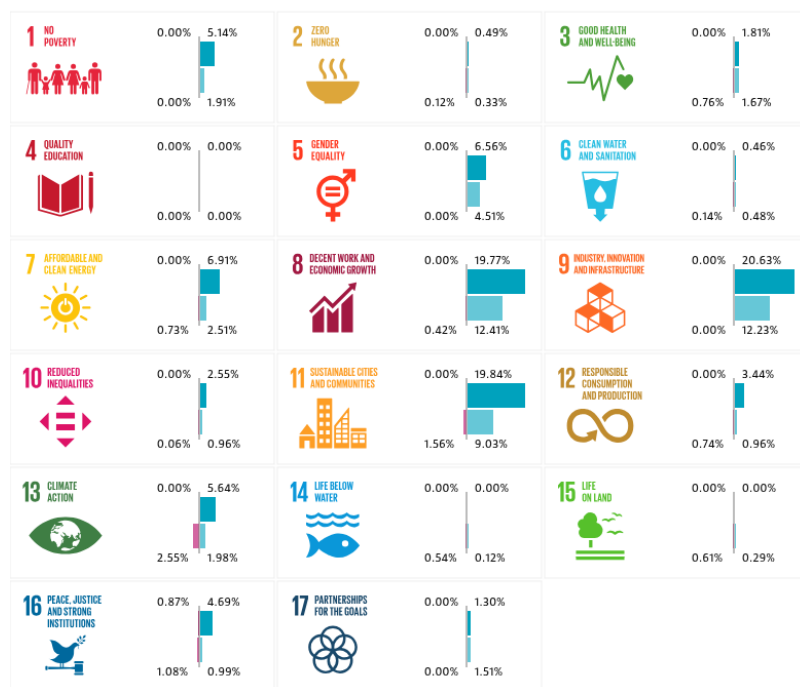
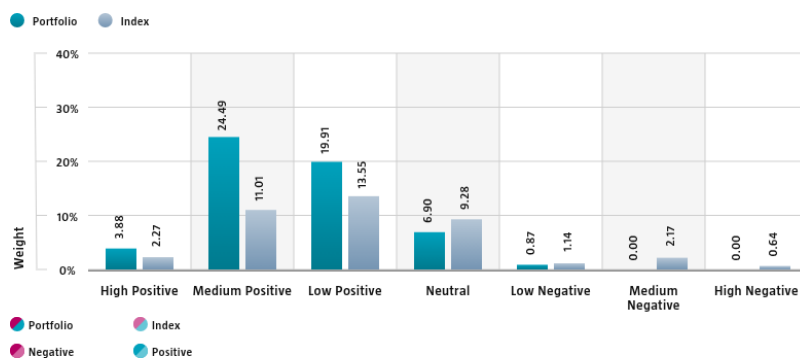

SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. The framework utilizes a three-step approach to assess a company's impact alignment with the relevant SDGs and assign a total SDG score. The score ranges from positive to negative impact alignment with levels from high, medium or low impact alignment. This results in a 7-step scale from -3 to +3. For comparison, index figures are provided alongside that of the portfolio. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

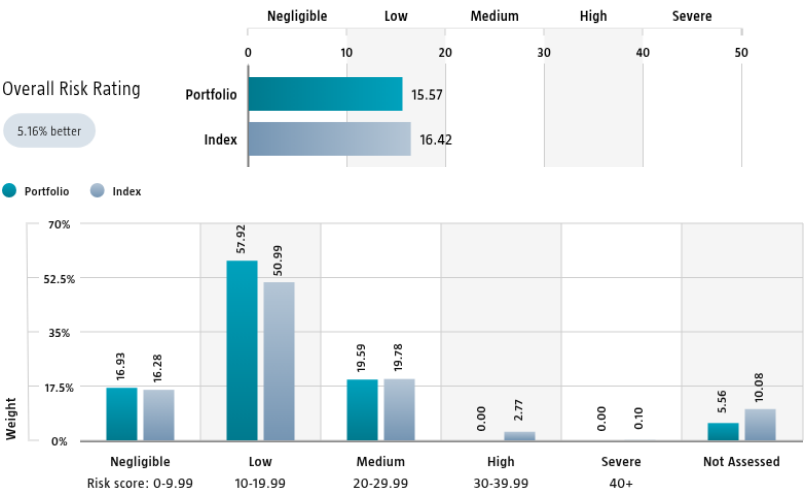

Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

The Portfolio Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating chart displays the portfolio's ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. The Distribution across Sustainalytics ESG Risk levels chart shows the portfolio allocations broken into Sustainalytics' five ESG risk levels: negligible (0-10), low (10-20), medium (20-30), high (30-40) and severe (40+), providing an overview of portfolio exposure to the different ESG risk levels. 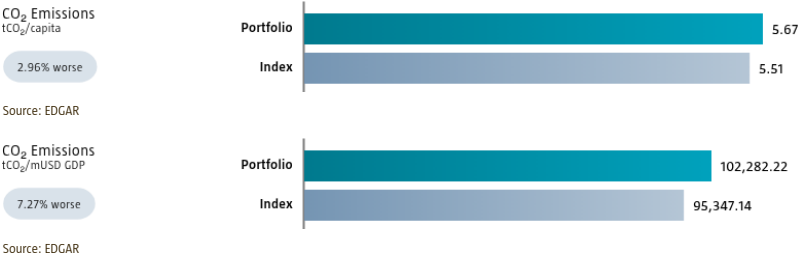

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Environmental Intensity - Government bond allocation

Environmental intensity expresses a portfolio's aggregate environmental efficiency. The portfolio's aggregate carbon intensity is based on the related country emissions. We divide each country's carbon emissions, measured in tCO₂, by the population size or gross domestic product to obtain the country's carbon intensity. The portfolio's aggregate intensity figures are calculated as a weighted average by multiplying each assessed portfolio component's intensity figure with its respective position weight. Index intensities are provided alongside the portfolio intensities, highlighting the portfolio's relative carbon intensity. Only holdings mapped as sovereign bonds are included in the figures.

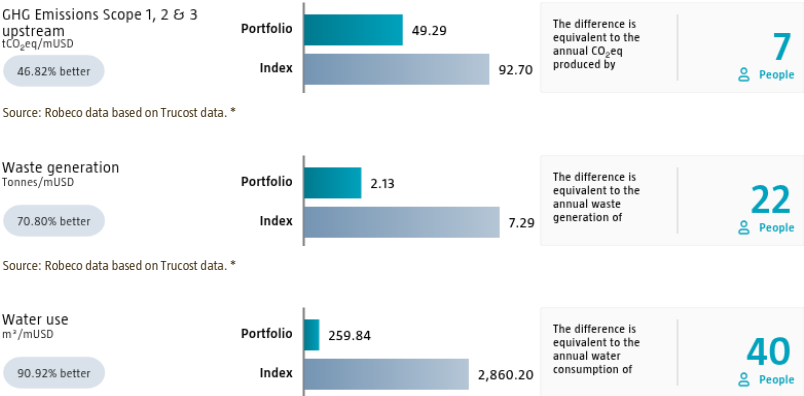

Environmental Footprint - Credit allocation

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. For comparison, index footprints are shown besides that of the portfolio. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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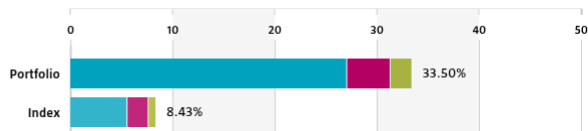

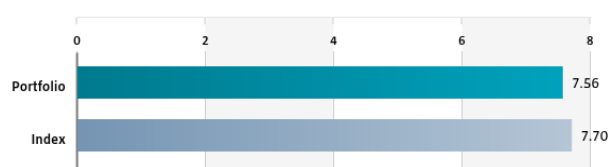

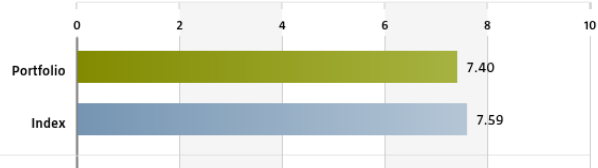

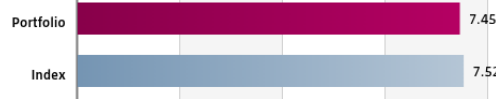

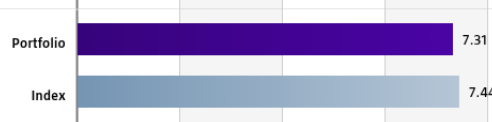

Engagement

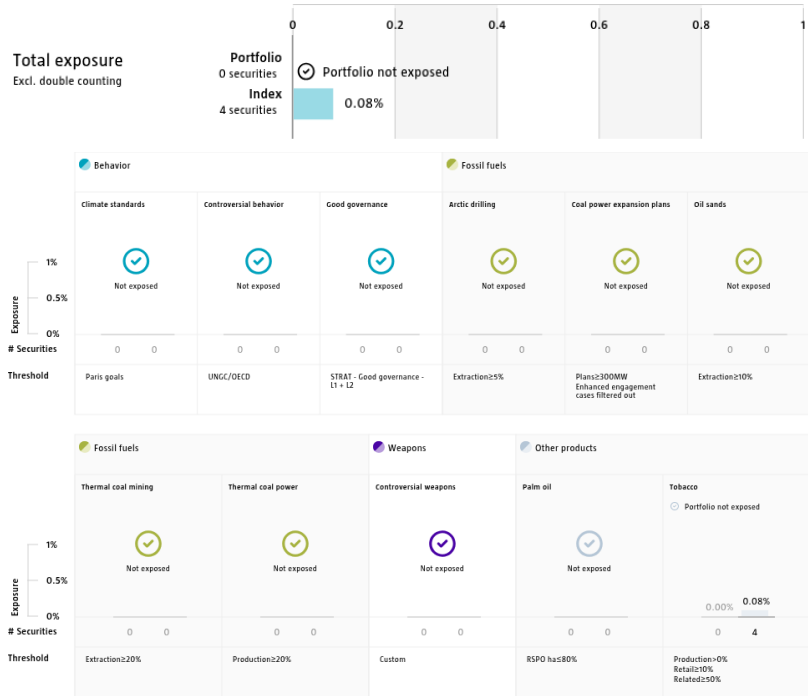
Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

Robeco Euro Short Duration Bonds is an actively managed sub-fund invests mainly in euro-denominated government and corporate bonds. The selection of these bonds is based on fundamental analysis. The Sub-fund invests in euro-denominated bonds and other euro-denominated marketable debt securities and instruments (which may include short dated fixed or floating rate securities) issued or guaranteed by OECD member states and by companies based in OECD countries.

The fund has sustainable investment as its objective within the meaning of Article 8 of the European Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation. The fund advances the UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) by investing in countries and companies whose business models and operational practices are aligned with targets defined by the 17 UN SDGs. The fund integrates ESG (Environmental, Social and Governance) factors in the investment process and applies Robeco's Good Governance policy and applies sustainability indicators, including but not limited to, normative, activity-based and region-based exclusions. The fund also has the ability to have an active dialogue with the invested companies to motivate these companies to improve their contribution to the UN SDGs. It does, however, not intend to acquire a large percentage of outstanding securities with the purpose of enabling the fund to significantly influence the management of invested companies.

Key risks

Michiel de Bruin is Head of Global Macro and a portfolio manager. Prior to joining Robeco in 2018, Michiel was Head of Global Rates and Money Markets at BMO Global Asset Management in London. He held various other positions before that, including Head of Euro Government Bonds. Before he joined BMO in 2003, he was, among others, Head of Fixed Income Trading at Deutsche Bank in Amsterdam. Michiel started his career in the industry in 1986. He holds a post graduate diploma investment analyses from the VU University in Amsterdam and is a Certified EFFAS Analyst (CEFA) charterholder. He holds a Bachelor's in Applied Sciences from University of Applied Sciences in Amsterdam. Stephan van Uzendoorn is a portfolio manager and member of the Global Macro team. Prior to joining Robeco in 2013, Stephan was employed by F&C Investments as a Portfolio Manager Fixed Income and worked in similar functions at Allianz Global Investors and A&O Services prior to that. Stephan started his career in the Investment Industry in 2003. He holds a Bachelor's in Financial Management, a Master's in Investment Management from VU University Amsterdam and is Certified European Financial Analyst (CEFA) Charterholder.

Fiscal treatment of investor

Investors who are not subject to (exempt from) Dutch corporate-income tax (e.g. pension funds) are not taxed on the achieved result. Investors who are subject to Dutch corporate-income tax can be taxed for the result achieved on their investment in the fund.
