Performance commentary

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was -1.74%.

In June, the fund outperformed the MSCI Emerging Markets Index, driven by stock selection while country allocation was neutral. Positive country allocation was driven by China (underweight) and South Korea (overweight). Negative country allocation came from India (underweight), Taiwan (underweight) and South Africa (overweight). The fund's investment in SK Square, the holding company of SK hynix, was the largest positive contributor to stock selection during the month, benefiting from a significantly stronger share price performance than SK hynix itself. In addition, the fund's position in SK Inc., the holding company of SK Square, also contributed positively. Other positive contributors included financial holdings, particularly CTBC Financial (Taiwan), Itaú Unibanco (Brazil), and ICICI Bank (India). On the negative side, stock selection was primarily affected by Petrobras (Brazil), reflecting weakness in the energy sector following the sharp decline in oil prices. Several Chinese internet holdings also detracted from performance, including Baidu, JD.com, and Trip.com, while CATL (EV batteries) and China Resources Land (property developer) underperformed during the month.

Market development

In June, emerging markets rose 0.6% (EUR), thereby underperforming versus developed markets that increased 1.3% (EUR). Emerging market equities navigated a challenging month in June as investors balanced shifting geopolitical developments, changing monetary policy expectations, and country-specific market dynamics. Market swings were particularly pronounced in South Korea, where the presence of leveraged ETF positions contributed to larger-than-usual price movements. Geopolitical tensions eased following a temporary agreement between the US and Iran, extending the ceasefire and allowing commercial traffic to resume through the Strait of Hormuz. Although a permanent agreement has yet to be reached and the risk of renewed tensions cannot be ruled out, the reduction in immediate concerns over energy supply disruptions provided some relief to global markets. The improvement in the geopolitical backdrop triggered a sharp reversal in energy markets, with crude oil prices falling by a fifth during the month as fears of supply shortages subsided. At the same time, the US Federal Reserve adopted a firmer policy stance than markets had anticipated at its June meeting.

Expectation of fund manager

The conflict in the Middle East is a significant shock with a big impact on the region and on global oil and gas prices. Even though the most likely scenario is that the conflict will be relatively short, risks do remain for a longer conflict and larger impact. Also economically, the US has become a source of more uncertainty on interest rate policy, important tariffs and policy making. Emerging markets are having to rely more on their own domestic policies and growth opportunities. We still expect higher structural economic growth compared to developed markets, while macroeconomic stability has significantly improved. Emerging equity markets' valuations have become attractive relative to developed markets, with discounts of more than 35% based on earnings multiples. Expected earnings growth is 46% for 2026 and 17% for 2027, both above developed markets.

Top 10 largest holdings

TSMC and Samsung Electronics are two globally leading technology companies that combine good growth prospects with relatively attractive valuations. The fund also has a significant position in holding company SK Square, which provides exposure to SK hynix, another leading semiconductor company, and trades at a large discount to its holdings. We also see good opportunities in banks in various emerging countries, as they provide domestic growth exposure at attractive valuations, often with high dividend payouts. Also, from various other industries, we see attractive valuations combined with high or better-than-expected growth opportunities, such as for Chinese battery company CATL and for South African holdings company Naspers, which has Chinese internet company Tencent as its key holding.

Sector allocation

Financials, consumer discretionary and information technology remain the largest sectors in the fund. In these sectors we find the best opportunities for companies that combine good growth prospects and attractive valuations. The underweight in information technology appears large, but good to note is that the fund owns a large position in SK Square, which is classified as industrial, but is basically a holding company for memory chips company SK hynix. Taking that into account would lower the effective underweight in technology stocks.

Country / Region allocation

In June, the fund increased its position in Samsung C&T, driven by the very large discount to its underlying investments despite reasonable corporate governance. In India, the fund added to its existing position of HDFC Bank, as underlying earnings have not changed much, while valuations have become more attractive. South Korea, China and Taiwan are the largest countries in the fund. In China, the fund invests in various sectors, having a relatively high weight in consumer goods and insurance, and a relatively low weight in banks, materials and energy. The fund also has a diversified position in South Korea, with the largest exposure being to the auto sector, banks, and technology companies Samsung Electronics and SK Square. In Taiwan, the fund invests mostly in technology companies. Brazil, South Africa and India are also larger positions in the fund with several holdings. Smaller country positions are Indonesia, Hungary, Thailand, the United Arab Emirates, Mexico, Vietnam, Greece, Poland, Turkey and Peru. Finally, the position in Singapore relates to a Chinese company that is listed in Singapore, but with all key operations within China.

Currency allocation

The fund has a relatively small short USD forward contract versus the EUR, in order to benefit from a weakening of the USD. Increasing political risks in the United States, along with a large current account deficit and a rising fiscal deficit driven by expansionary policies, are negative factors for the US dollar.

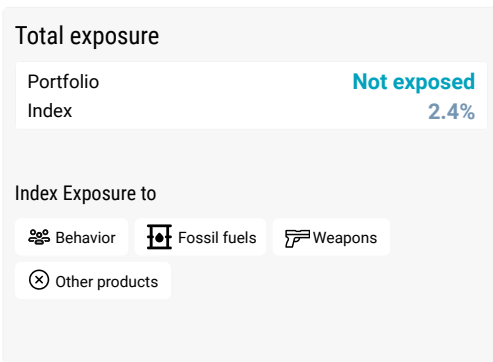

1. SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. The framework utilizes a three-step approach to assess a company's impact alignment with the relevant SDGs and assign a total SDG score. The score ranges from positive to negative impact alignment with levels from high, medium or low impact alignment. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

2. Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index (where applicable) represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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3. Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

The chart displays the portfolio's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. The distribution across Sustainalytics ESG Risk levels chart shows the portfolio allocations broken into Sustainalytics' five ESG risk levels: negligible (0-10), low (10-20), medium (20-30), high (30-40) and severe (40+), providing an overview of portfolio exposure to the different ESG risk levels. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

4. Exclusions

5. Engagement

Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

Risk management

Risk management is fully integrated into the investment process to ensure that positions always meet predefined guidelines.

Fiscal product treatment

The fund is established in Luxembourg and is subject to the Luxembourg tax laws and regulations. The fund is not liable to pay any corporation, income, dividend or capital gains tax in Luxembourg. The fund is subject to an annual subscription tax ('tax d'abonnement') in Luxembourg, which amounts to 0.05% of the net asset value of the fund. This tax is included in the net asset value of the fund. The fund can in principle use the Luxembourg treaty network to partially recover any withholding tax on its income.

Fiscal treatment of investor

The fiscal consequences of investing in this fund depend on the investor's personal situation. For private investors in the Netherlands real interest and dividend income or capital gains received on their investments are not relevant for tax purposes. Each year investors pay income tax on the value of their net assets as at 1 January if and inasmuch as such net assets exceed the investor's tax-free allowance. Any amount invested in the fund forms part of the investor's net assets. Private investors who are resident outside the Netherlands will not be taxed in the Netherlands on their investments in the fund. However, such investors may be taxed in their country of residence on any income from an investment in this fund based on the applicable national fiscal laws. Other fiscal rules apply to legal entities or professional investors. We advise investors to consult their financial or tax adviser about the tax consequences of an investment in this fund in their specific circumstances before deciding to invest in the fund.
