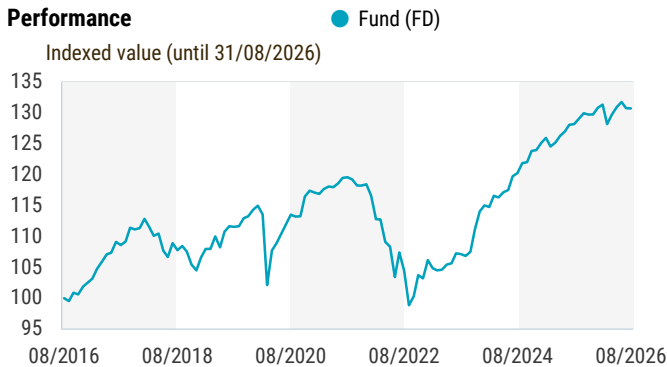

About the fund

Robeco Financial Institutions Bonds is an actively managed fund that mainly invests in subordinated debt issued by banks and insurance companies, primarily from Europe. The fund has a strong focus on Tier 2 debt, while having some flexibility to invest off-Benchmark in Contingent Convertible Bonds (also "coco" bonds), senior bonds and non-Euro denominated debt. The selection of these bonds is based on fundamental analysis. Performance drivers are the top-down beta positioning as well as bottom-up issuer selection. The fund's objective is to provide long-term capital growth.

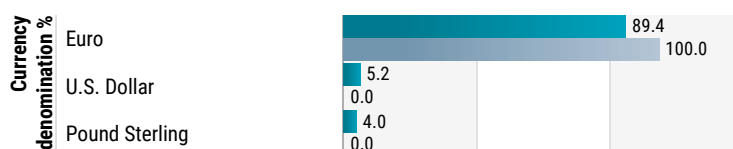
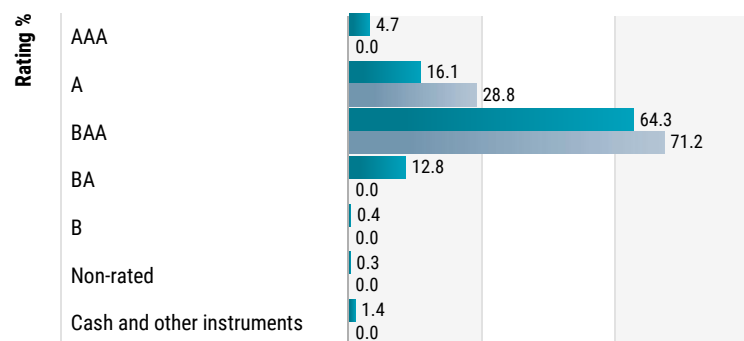
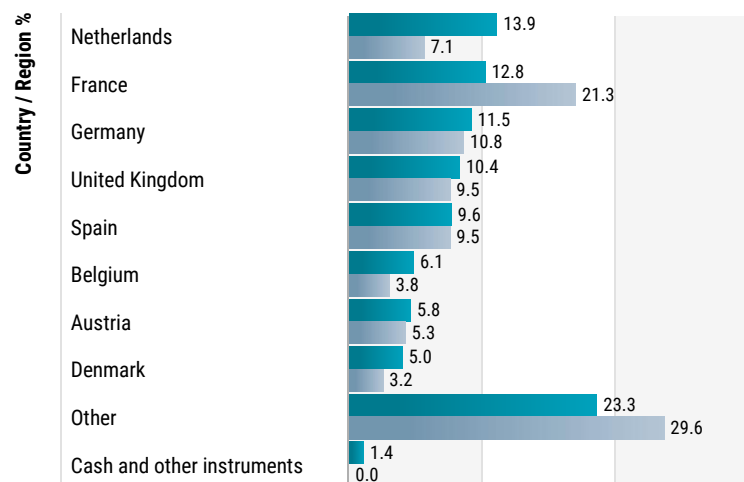
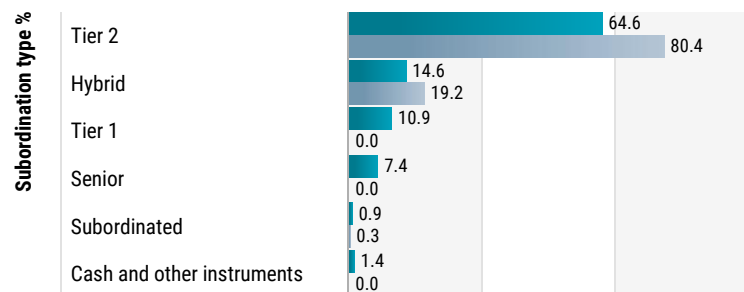
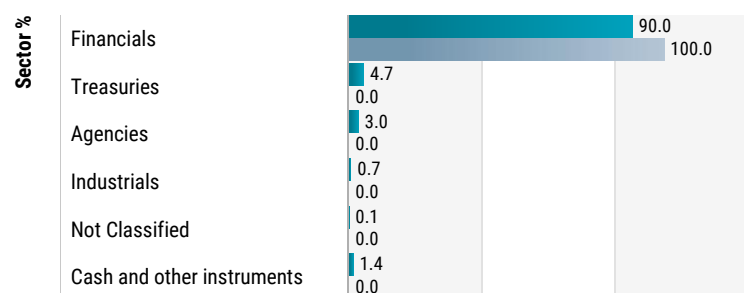
The benchmark of the fund is Bloomberg Barclays Euro-Aggregate: Corporates Financials Subordinated 2% Issuer Cap (EUR). The fund aims to outperform by taking positions that deviate from the benchmark within predefined risk limits. This share class of the fund hedged the interest rate duration until 10 December 2019 to nearly zero, therefore the benchmark of the fund was not representative. Since 11 December 2019, the duration hedge was removed and the benchmark is representative to compare the fund performance.

Key risks

Performance commentary

Based on transaction prices, the fund's return was -0.03%.

The fund generated a mildly negative total return in August, driven by the rise in government bond yields. 5-year German Bund yields increased to 3.06% from 2.94% at the end of July. The benchmark's credit excess return amounted to 1 basis point, as positive carry offset a modest widening in average index spreads to 114 basis points, from 113 basis points the previous month. The portfolio outperformed the index by 10 basis points. The portfolio maintained a slight overweight beta position during the period. However, given the lack of direction in credit spreads, market beta made only a negligible contribution to relative performance. The largest source of outperformance was issuer selection. Key positive contributors included overweight positions in Deutsche Bank, mBank, BBVA, Rabobank and Barclays. The underweight position in French insurers also contributed positively to performance. Negative contributions came from overweight positions in AXA and BNP Paribas, although these were more than offset by the portfolio's overall underweight exposure to French issuers. Underweight positions in Sampo, Mapfre and Euroclear were also modest detractors from performance.

Market development

Market volatility in August remained concentrated primarily in government bond markets rather than in credit markets. 5-year German Bund yields increased by 12 basis points to 3.06%. At the same time, sovereign risk premiums in the Eurozone continued to rise. French OAT spreads, measured relative to 10-year Bunds, widened by a further 6 basis points during the month. Year-to-date, this metric has widened by 14 basis points, driven by continued concerns about the sustainability of French government deficits. The rise in European rates was partly driven by developments at the long end of the US Treasury market, which continues to face pressure due to concerns about the US fiscal deficit. Economic data from both Europe and the United States indicated that growth momentum remains solid. During his Jackson Hole speech, Federal Reserve President Warsh delivered a more hawkish message than expected, prompting markets to price in additional Federal Reserve rate hikes. Credit spreads remained relatively stable throughout the month. Carry-oriented instruments, such as subordinated financials, continued to deliver solid returns.

Expectation of fund manager

Credit spreads have reached cycle lows. At the same time, the financial sector is fundamentally performing well. Balance sheets look robust after years of deleveraging. Profitability has benefited from higher interest rates, strong cost control, and a healthy growth in fee income. Looking ahead, we expect profitability to plateau at a higher level than that observed in the period between the global financial crisis and the Covid-19 crisis. We do not expect central banks to return to a zero-rate environment, while banks have made significant progress in improving their underlying profitability. As such, banks' resilience to external shocks has improved considerably. Demand for higher-yielding bonds remains strong, as investors seek to lock in attractive yield levels. We are selective when participating in new bond issues, as spreads have tightened and structural features have become increasingly important. We maintain a modest overweight beta position in the fund, balancing strong fundamentals against valuations that are becoming more demanding. At the same time, we believe we can continue to generate excess returns through our credit selection in both primary and secondary markets.

Top 10 largest holdings

The fund has a benchmark that caps benchmark weights at 2%. Holdings typically consist of exposures to large and strong banks and insurance companies.

Sector allocation

The fund only invests in financials – excess cash may be invested in (German) government bonds. Government-owned banks such as Belfius Bank, ASN Bank and Permanent TSB are classified under Agencies and Local Authorities. The exposure to industrials relates to bonds issued by Renault Bank and Volkswagen Bank.

Country / Region allocation

Country allocation is largely driven by a bottom-up investment approach. We are underweight in France, as spreads remain tight and sovereign risk is not adequately priced in. The largest overweight positions are in the Netherlands, Belgium, and Mexico. These exposures include both insurance companies and banks and are primarily driven by the positive operating momentum of the underlying issuers, combined with a solid top-down economic backdrop.

Currency denomination allocation

The fund is allowed to invest in currencies other than euros. Approximately 9% of the fund is invested in bonds issued in pound sterling and US dollar. All foreign currency exposures are hedged.

Duration allocation

The fund mostly runs an interest rate position that is neutral versus the benchmark, but deviations from this neutral position are possible.

Rating allocation

The fund does not follow an active rating strategy – the current rating allocation is a result of bottom-up bond selection. The fund is allowed to invest in high yield to a maximum of 20%; the current exposure is circa 13%.

Subordination allocation

The largest part of the portfolio is invested in Tier-2 debt. About 80% of these bonds are issued by banks, while the remainder is issued by insurance companies. The categories hybrid and subordinated mostly contain subordinated debt issued by insurance companies. The exposure under Tier 1 primarily relates to bank CoCos. The exposure to senior bonds mainly consists of German Bunds, although we also hold senior bank bonds issued by institutions such as mBank and Banca Transilvania.

1. SDG Impact Alignment

This distribution across SDG scores shows the portfolio weight allocated to companies with a positive, negative and neutral impact alignment with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) based on Robeco's SDG Framework. The framework utilizes a three-step approach to assess a company's impact alignment with the relevant SDGs and assign a total SDG score. The score ranges from positive to negative impact alignment with levels from high, medium or low impact alignment. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

2. Environmental Footprint

Environmental footprint expresses the total resource consumption of the portfolio per mUSD invested. Each assessed company's footprint is calculated by normalizing resources consumed by the company's enterprise value including cash (EVIC). We aggregate these figures to portfolio level using a weighted average, multiplying each assessed portfolio constituent's footprint by its respective position weight. The equivalent factors that are used for comparison between the portfolio and index (where applicable) represent European averages and are based on third-party sources combined with own estimates. As such, the figures presented are intended for illustrative purposes and are purely an indication. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

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3. Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating

The chart displays the portfolio's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating. This is calculated by multiplying each portfolio component's Sustainalytics ESG Risk Rating by its respective portfolio weight. The distribution across Sustainalytics ESG Risk levels chart shows the portfolio allocations broken into Sustainalytics' five ESG risk levels: negligible (0-10), low (10-20), medium (20-30), high (30-40) and severe (40+), providing an overview of portfolio exposure to the different ESG risk levels. Only holdings mapped as corporates are included in the figures.

4. Exclusions

5. ESG Labeled Bonds

The visual displays the portfolio's exposure to ESG-labeled bonds. This is calculated as a sum of weights for those bonds in the portfolio that have one of above mentioned labels. Index exposure figures are provided alongside the portfolio exposure figures, highlighting the difference with the index.

6. Engagement

Robeco distinguishes between three types of engagement. Value Engagement focuses on long-term issues that are financially material and/or are causing adverse sustainability impacts. The themes can be broken into Environmental, Social, Governance, or Voting-related. SDG Engagement aims to drive a clear and measurable improvement in a company's SDG contribution. Enhanced engagement is triggered by misconduct and focuses on companies severely breaching international standards. The report is based on all companies in the portfolio for which engagement activities have taken place during the past 12 months. Note that companies may be under engagement in multiple categories simultaneously. While the total portfolio exposure excludes double counting, it may not equal the sum of individual category exposures.

Risk management

Risk management is fully embedded in the investment process to ensure that positions always meet predefined guidelines.

Fiscal product treatment

The fund is established in Luxembourg and is subject to the Luxembourg tax laws and regulations. The fund is not liable to pay any corporation, income, dividend or capital gains tax in Luxembourg. The fund is subject to an annual subscription tax ('tax d'abonnement') in Luxembourg, which amounts to 0.01% of the net asset value of the fund. This tax is included in the net asset value of the fund. The fund can in principle use the Luxembourg treaty network to partially recover any withholding tax on its income.

Fiscal treatment of investor

Investors who are not subject to (exempt from) Dutch corporate-income tax (e.g. pension funds) are not taxed on the achieved result. Investors who are subject to Dutch corporate-income tax can be taxed for the result achieved on their investment in the fund. Dutch bodies that are subject to corporate-income tax are obligated to declare interest and dividend income, as well as capital gains in their tax return. Investors residing outside the Netherlands are subject to their respective national tax regime applying to foreign investment funds.
