

European indices outperform global benchmarks with strong sector gains

- Health Care and Financial sectors drive positive returns
- Robeco 3D European Equity well positioned across its five main factors
- Targeting a long-term information ratio of 0.8

In November 2025, the fund achieved a return of 1.2%, outperforming the MSCI Europe Index, which posted a return of 0.9%. This resulted in a positive excess return of 0.3%.

1. Market developments

The majority of European indices delivered positive returns in November, resulting in an outperformance relative to the global and Emerging Markets equity benchmarks. The principal contributors were stocks within the Health Care and Financial sectors: Roche increased 18% on the back of promising late-stage drug trial results. AstraZeneca rose 12% following a strong earnings release. BNP Paribas added 10%, continuing the positive momentum observed across the banking sector. The Information Technology (IT) sector was the weakest performer, with stocks such as SAP (-8%) and ASML (-2%) being impacted by the global weakness in the technology sector. In terms of investment styles, European value stocks outperformed the market index, adding to their substantial year-to-date performance, while growth stocks experienced a marginal pullback last month.

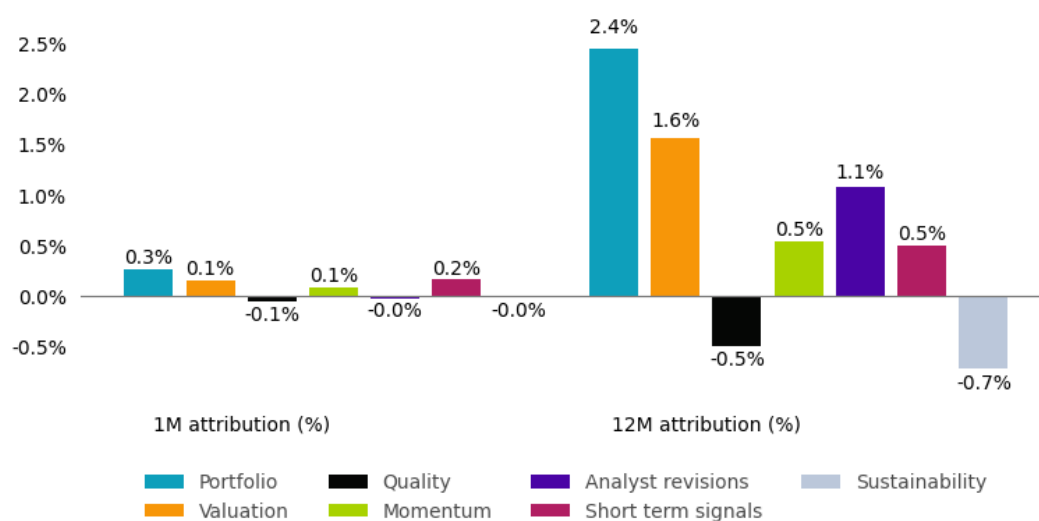

2. Performance attribution

In November, our portfolio achieved a modest outperformance against the benchmark. The short-term signals were the primary contributor to the fund's relative performance, while valuation, momentum, sustainability, analyst revisions, and quality remained neutral.

Over the past 12 months, the strategy has shown a positive relative return. Valuation led the contributions, followed by analyst revisions, momentum, and short-term signals, all of which positively impacted the fund's performance. While quality and sustainability detracted from returns, the overall performance reflects the strength of the strategy in navigating the market.

3. Positioning

Stock selection is the main driver of the Enhanced Indexing model. All position deviations from the benchmark are based in the relative attractiveness of these stocks from a multi-factor perspective as compared to their regional/sector peers. The resulting portfolio is well-diversified with small deviations on sector and country levels, as shown in the figure below.

The fund remains well-positioned towards the model factors. A comparison of various characteristics of the portfolio versus those of its benchmark – the MSCI Europe Index – shows a consistent picture: the portfolio offers a lower valuation and better quality, momentum and revisions.

To illustrate, the current P/E of the fund is 15.3 compared to 16.2 for the MSCI Europe Index. In terms of quality, the portfolio has a net buyback yield of 0.9%, which is slightly higher than the 0.8% yield of the benchmark. From a momentum perspective, the portfolio's 12-minus-1 month momentum stands at 21.5%, exceeding the MSCI Europe Index's momentum of 20.4%. Additionally, the portfolio's earnings revisions ratio is 53.9%, while the benchmark shows a ratio of 48.7%.

Given these characteristics, we firmly believe the strategy is well-positioned to continue harvesting the model factor premiums.

The fund aims for a better sustainability profile compared to the benchmark by promoting certain sustainability characteristics within the meaning of Article 8 of the European Sustainable Finance Disclosure Regulation and integrating sustainability in the investment process. More specifically, the binding elements as per the prospectus and sustainability disclosure (SFDR disclosure) pertain to applying the Robeco Level 2 exclusion list, excluding stocks that have a high negative SDG score of -3 according to our Robeco SDG Framework, targeting a Sustainalytics ESG risk rating that is 5% better than the benchmark (the Sustainalytics ESG risk rating offers insight into company-level ESG risk by measuring the size of an organization's unmanaged ESG risk, a lower score refers to a better overall sustainability profile), and pursuing 20% better carbon (as measured by greenhouse gas emissions), waste and water footprints than the benchmark.

Table 5 below shows the current main over- and underweights as a result of our bottom-up stock-selection process.

The portfolio's highest active weights were in Italgas SpA at 0.64% and GSK plc at 0.63%. Conversely, the largest underweights were in Airbus at -1.1% and Safran at -0.97%.
