## Market review and developments

Asian markets rose 5.9% in February, continuing the outperformance relative to developed markets (+0.8%). AI impact continues to be a dominant market driver through multiple different channels, while political and geopolitical developments also played a large role. On the AI front, the rapid rise in agentic/coding/multi-modal capability is showing up both in a sell-off in software names on obsolescence risks and further gains in select hardware names. Notably, the hyperscalers actually doing the capex have not seen material share price upside in several months now as investors continue to debate long-term return generation in an environment of insignificant moats. The dramatic software vs. hardware split also played out in Asia, most notably with Korea memory names rallying (Korea IT +28%) and India IT services tumbling (India IT -18%). On the (geo)political front, elections (in Japan and Thailand) proved material catalysts, and the unwind of IEEPA tariffs and late-month US strike on Iran are still playing out in markets. Thailand (+20.9%) rose on hopes for political stability after a strong showing by the

Bhumjaithai Party. Korea (+22.6%) rose on renewed optimism about governance reforms with the passage of the third revision of the Commercial Code. Local retail investors' buying both in stocks and ETFs was sufficient to offset profit-taking outflows from foreign investors. The software drag on India (+1.1%) was not offset enough by the India-US trade deal. Driven by idiosyncratic regulatory headlines and software obsolescence concerns, China's internet stocks recorded their largest monthly losses (KWEB: -12.2%) in two years, making China (-5.8%) the worst-performing market. Hong Kong (+2.7%) outperformed China, supported by improved macro indicators (retail, housing, exports) and stronger government fiscal conditions. ASEAN (+3.5%) delivered mixed performance, with Thailand's gains offset by Indonesia's (-1.4%) ongoing volatility post MSCI announcements in Jan.

Oil prices recorded moderate gains (Brent +2.5%, WTI +2.8% pre-Iran attack) amid heightened geopolitical uncertainty, with markets closely tracking developments between the US and Iran. Industrial metals had a relatively modest performance in February. The nullification of IEEPA tariffs reintroduced macro uncertainty on the tariff trajectory. Copper (+1.4%) and aluminum (+0.3%) moved sideways for the most part. Precious metals continued to grind higher with silver rallying 18.0% and gold up 7.9% in February amid rising likelihood of military action by the US against Iran, continued central bank purchases of gold, and lower market pricing of Fed rates. Strong industrial demand and an undersupplied market further contributed to the rally in silver prices.

In February on the ESG front, Indonesia announced that it would raise its mandatory bioethanol blend in gasoline to 10% by 2028, signaling stronger commitments to renewable fuels and reduced oil dependence. India launched a USD 166m initiative to modernize critical mineral recycling, aiming to secure supply chains and support clean-energy-related industries. China's solar power installed capacity is projected to surpass coal for the first time in 2026, marking a major milestone in its energy transition.

### Last month's performance

In February, Robeco Sustainable Asian Stars outperformed the index. India and Taiwan were the biggest contributor. Stock selection in China and Vietnam detracted this month. In terms of sectors, stock selection was positive in Communication Services and IT but detracted in Consumer Discretionary.

On the positive side, AI exposure rallied further in February: Chroma ATE, Sk Hynix & Samsung Electronics Pref performed well. Korea experienced strong sentiment in February also thanks to value-up programs; our holdings in KT Corp and Samsung Life benefitted.

Conversely, not owning Samsung Electronics and the underweight in TSMC detracted. Huatai Securities announced a rights issue that surprised the market. Tencent in China was weak, driven by VAT-increase concerns and worries on the slow progress of its AI capabilities. FPT Corp was also hit by software worries.

The fund is significantly invested in Financials, IT, and Consumer sectors. We are confident that Asia is strategically positioned to capitalize on the forthcoming advancements in the internet of things, 5G, and AI technologies. This belief strongly supports our recommendation for investors to overweight their portfolios towards Asia. Within the region, we identify compelling value opportunities throughout the supply chain. Additionally, we favor IT services companies that facilitate this technological transformation. The growing trend towards healthy living in Asia presents thrilling long-term investment opportunities, driven by increased awareness and demand for a sustainable lifestyle. Financial inclusion and the accumulation of wealth in Asia will benefit well-positioned financial enterprises over the next decade, encompassing areas such as insurance, retail banking, and fintech. Specifically, we prefer financial firms with solid capital reserves, appealing valuations, and robust growth potential. Our investments in renewable utilities have also grown in regions where attractive valuations, positive earnings revisions, and energy transition themes converge.



We like sustainable companies with solid cash flow generation, trading at a good price, having positive momentum and low environmental footprint. We like the technology enablers in Asia that can help enhance energy efficiency and realize exciting applications such as autonomous driving, Internet of Things and Artificial Intelligence. SK Hynix, TSMC and KT Corp are the best exposures in our view. We like banks in countries where we can expect structural growth through financial inclusion as well as strong fintech capabilities. ICICI Bank, Bank Rakyat and Huatai Securities are examples of that. Asian companies have strong presence in smart mobility supply chain globally, Hyundai Mobis and Chroma ATE are great exposures with re-rating potential. Healthy living is a long-term theme for the growing middle class in Asia. Tencent and Alibaba are such exposures. Companies involved in renewable energy with good value and positive earnings revision such as China Datang Renewables and Nari Technology are also large holdings in our portfolio.


Our portfolio's country exposure arises from a bottom-up approach to stock selection. China, Korea, and India hold significant weight in our investments. China offers a wealth of companies in clean energy, electric vehicles, and technology, making it a pivotal theme in our portfolio. The country is actively transitioning its policy to support growth, so we concentrate on sustainable beneficiaries while avoiding areas prone to policy intervention. Korea's

corporate governance reform agenda has gained market recognition. We anticipate more concrete actions will unfold in the coming months, though earnings cyclicality will be a litmus test for shareholder return improvement in Korea. India and Indonesia showcase numerous long-term growth themes such as financial inclusion and energy transition. We target robust companies capable of delivering positive earnings revisions at reasonable valuations. Additionally, we favor Vietnam due to its positive long-term earnings growth prospects combined with low valuations, although tariff uncertainties could lead to slower growth in the near term.

Sustainable investing


Sustainability is a key principle in our investment approach, with ESG playing a crucial role in our investment process as it enhances our insight into companies' risk and reward profiles. We incorporate a comprehensive ESG-integrated fundamental analysis with valuation adjustments for bottom-up stock selection. The Robeco sustainability criteria and company scores based on these criteria are vital input factors for our assessment of potential investments. Companies with higher scores are more likely to be part of the portfolio. Additionally, we seek out sustainability-themed ideas across Asia that have not yet attracted market attention. Moreover, we strive to ensure our portfolio maintains a low environmental footprint. The graph below illustrates the results for the relative environmental impact of our portfolio: all our holdings exhibit a lower environmental impact across all categories, notably including an exceptionally low relative carbon footprint.

The GHG emissions charts show a portfolio's aggregate greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions intensity (also known as carbon intensity) based on Scope 1&2 as well as based on Scope 1, 2, & 3. We calculate each company's GHG emissions intensity by dividing the company's absolute GHG emissions by its annual revenues. A company's total GHG emissions can be broken into Scope 1, 2, and 3. Scope 2 represents the indirect emissions from the production of the electricity or heat used, and Scope 3 represents the indirect emissions from creating products and services (upstream activities). ### Outlook

Recent geopolitical developments in the Middle East have triggered a short-term risk-off episode following a strong market run. Historical experience suggests that, absent material escalation, such shocks tend to fade and equity performance reverts to being driven by fundamentals. The recent pullback is therefore viewed as a healthy correction rather than a change in the underlying investment case. Valuations across Asia remain attractive, with equities still trading at a meaningful discount to the US, despite the rally year-to-date. The sell-off has further improved entry points, and we have been selectively redeploying cash raised from recent profit-taking into areas of market weakness.

Looking ahead, a combination of more attractive valuations, a still-wide valuation gap versus the US, and supportive earnings revisions should continue to underpin capital flows into the region. While risks remain – notably geopolitical uncertainty, elevated order books in parts of the technology sector, and the gradual narrowing of valuation differentials – the balance of risks and rewards remains favorable.

Asian markets are still 30% cheaper than global markets and continues to offer a compelling medium-term opportunity, supported by improving fundamentals, relative valuation appeal, and scope for incremental policy support in a more uncertain global backdrop. We focus on bottom-up stock picking and on companies with a good sustainability profile, solid cash flow generation, trading at a good price and having positive momentum.
