Robeco appoints Ivo Frielink as interim Global Head of Sales & Marketing

Rotterdam, 18 August 2025- Robeco has appointed Ivo Frielink as interim Global Head of Sales & Marketing. He succeeds Malick Badjie, who will formally step down from the Executive Committee and leave the company.

Frielink started his career with Robeco Netherlands in 2005. Over the years he held several positions, including Regional Business Manager APAC. In 2022, he was appointed to Robeco's Executive Committee as Head of Strategic Product & Business Development.
